

**Prerequisite (noun)** — something required before something else happens.

- A visa is a prerequisite for traveling abroad.
- Trust is a prerequisite for strong relationships.

**Pivotal (adjective)** — extremely important, central.

- Speech played a pivotal role in human history.
- That decision was pivotal for the company's future.

**Cognitive (adjective)** — related to thinking and mental processes.

- Learning a language boosts cognitive skills.
- Lack of sleep affects cognitive performance.

**Conceptualize (verb)** — to form an idea in your mind.

- She conceptualized a new online course.
- It's difficult to conceptualize infinity.

**Hierarchical (adjective)** — organized in ranked levels.

- The company has a hierarchical structure.
- Language lets us build hierarchical ideas.

**Symbolic (adjective)** — representing something beyond its literal meaning.

- The dove is symbolic of peace.
- Words are symbolic tools for ideas.

**Resonance (noun)** — lasting emotional or mental effect.

- His story had a deep resonance.
- Old songs often carry emotional resonance.

**Mobilize (verb)** — to organize people/resources for action.

- They mobilized volunteers for the event.
- Leaders mobilize communities with words.

**Emphasize (verb)** — to give special importance.

- The teacher emphasized regular practice.
- The ad emphasizes quality over price.

**Abstract (adjective)** — not physical, existing in thought.

- Justice is an abstract idea.
- Abstract concepts can be hard to explain.

**Merely (adverb)** — only, simply.

- It's merely a suggestion.
- She was merely curious, not serious.

**Thus far (adverb)** — until now, up to this point.

- The results have been good thus far.
- Thus far, no solution has appeared.

**Materialize (verb)** — to happen or become real.

- His plan didn't materialize.
- The threat never materialized.

**Heal (verb)** — to make healthy again (body or situation).

- Time can heal old wounds.
- They tried to heal their friendship.

**Retain (verb)** — to keep or continue having something.

- It's hard to retain new words without practice.
- She retained her confidence despite setbacks.

**Champion (verb)** — to actively support a cause/idea.

- He championed free education.
- She champions mental health awareness.
