The story to watch this week is the unfolding defamation case between Moira Deeming and John Pesutto. Each day there have been new (and shocking) revelations about what really went on behind the scenes in Victoria. There seems to be a general consensus – certainly if you read Edie Wyatt's excellent piece this week – that the Victorian Liberal Leadership has made a terrible error in judgement with the way it chose to handle Deeming and the Let Women Speak rally in general. Is there any future for the Pesutto leadership after all this legal dust has settled? It seems unlikely.

There are currently three bills that actively seek to silence the political speech of Australians, all of which enjoy support of Labor, the Greens, and a scary number of Liberals who should know better. By now, most people are aware of the Misinformation and Disinformation Bill, along with the plot to kick teenagers off

social media. Well, now there's also a new Hate Speech Bill which many fear will allow the LGBTQ+ community to weaponise the law against conservative criticism of various activist movements. To some extent this is already happening, but with the power of Parliament behind them, many fear we are swiftly headed toward a Chinese-style method of political speech.

As we put this email to bed on Friday, it appears – and we do not wish to jinx anything here – that the government no longer has the numbers to pass the MAD bill through the Senate. Following a massive campaign to call the undecided Senators, several have announced on social media that they will not support the Misinformation and Disinformation Bill. If this turns out to be true, and they keep their word, Australia has narrowly avoided the most coercive regulations regarding social media of any country in the English Speaking World – and that is saying something, considering we are competing with the famously draconian EU and Starmer's two tier Britain. However, while one victory may be imminent, the under 16 social media ban could be even more subversive and dangerous with its requirement to implement Digital ID and facial recognition for all social media users. This proposal has the support of Labor and the Liberal Party. Unless there is some kind of huge public backlash, it will likely breeze

through before Christmas, as Dutton has requested.

Regardless of what social media laws are passed, the eSafety Commission is going to be one of the first victims of the Trump presidency. With news coming through later in the week that Trump intends to pass a law preventing social media from policing speech in a way that violates US free speech protections – Twitter, Facebook, and any other social media platform based in the US will be unable to comply with takedown orders from the eSafety Commission. What happens if Australia then threatens Trump's political friend, Elon Musk, with huge fines? Our best guess? A few nasty trade tariffs. The truth is, Australia may be forced to abandon social media restrictions entirely or risk a geopolitical disaster.
