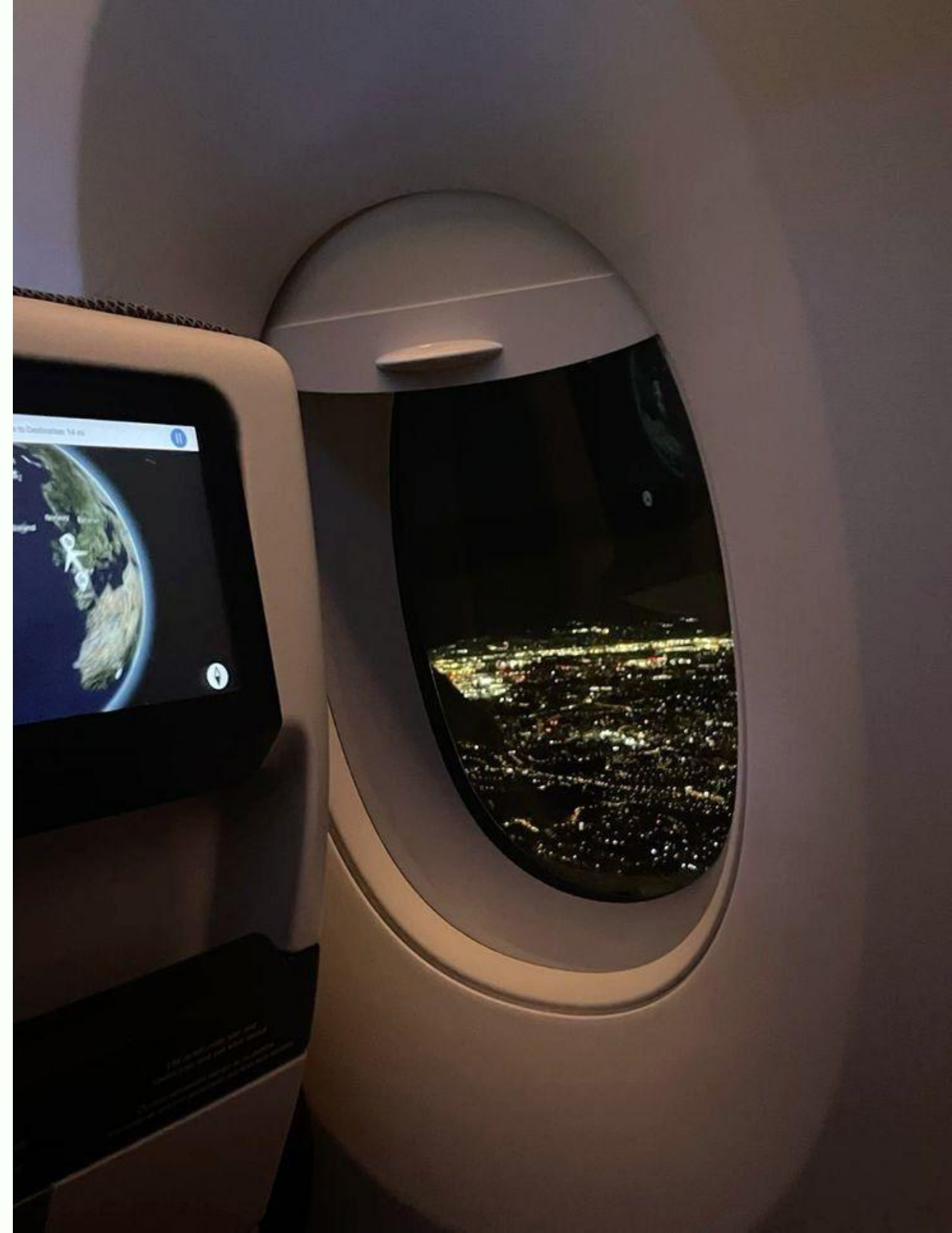

Common Phrases

- Can I have the bill, please?

Dietary Requests

- I'm allergic to...
- Is this dish vegetarian?
- Could you make it less spicy?

Hello, I have a reservation under the name...

Information Needed

Could you tell me about check-out time?

3

Requests

Is breakfast included? Can I have extra towels?

4

Checking Out

I'm ready to check out now. Could I have my bill?



Dealing with Transport

Public Transport

- What time is the next train?
- Which bus goes to the city centre?
- Is this the right platform?

Taxis

- Could you take me to this address?
- How much will the ride cost?
- Please wait here.



Emergency Situations

Calling for Help

Call the police! I need an ambulance!

Describing the Problem

There has been an accident. Someone is injured.

Asking for Assistance

Can you help me? I've lost my passport.
