- "Visited and enjoyed" – **Parallel verbs**.
- **"Located in the southern part of Uzbekistan..."**
- **Past participle phrase** ("located...") used as extra information about the noun "village."
- **"I went there last spring..."**
- **Clear time expression with past simple** ("went").
- **"We spent two days exploring..."**
- **"Spent + time + verb-ing"** structure = correct and natural.
- **"We were offered fresh bread..."**
- **Passive voice** – used to focus on the action/experience, not the doer.
- **"What I loved most was the calmness and beauty..."**
- **Emphatic structure** starting with "What I loved most..." adds feeling and fluency.
- **"It helped me slow down, breathe, and appreciate..."**
- **Infinitive verbs in a list** – all parallel, natural, and smooth.
