Drawing on his personal experiences, Levsha began mentoring students for Top University Admissions. 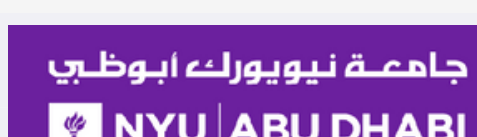
