One such animal is the lemur. There are 25 **species** of lemur on Madagascar and all of them are endangered. The lemur is a monkey-like animal with large round eyes, a pointed nose, a long tail and soft woolly fur. The largest lemur, the indri, is about 95 cm long, the smallest, the mouse lemur, is only 15 cm long. All lemurs are vegetarians. They like wild figs, bananas and other forest fruits.

The mountain gorillas live on the slopes of volcanoes in Rwanda, Zaire and Uganda. They live in small groups led by a **dominant** male. They are too big and heavy to climb trees and so they wander slowly through the forest eating fruits, leaves and berries. **They** are the largest of the great apes and look very dangerous. But scientists say they are gentle, intelligent and very friendly.

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The forest elephant lives in the Congo basin. It is much smaller than the African elephant, **which** is the biggest animal on Earth. Nevertheless, even this “small” elephant can be up to 250 cm tall. Its **ivory** is thinner, short and a bit yellowish.
