

ATTENTION:

All the details are crocheted in circular rows in a spiral for the both loops of the stitches.
All the exceptions are pointed in the description.

Use the marker or marker thread to point the end of the row.

NOTES:



FASTENING SLIP STITCH (FST SL ST)

Fastening slip stitch – it is the same slip stitch, but it is not crocheted, but it is made with the help of a needle. Such stitch makes the end of crocheting invisible, and the edge of the detail - even, and additionally fasten well a thread.

Order of the actions:

- 1. Insert the end of a thread, left after crocheting the detail, in a needle.
- 2. Insert a needle from the front to the back for the both loops in a stitch next for the last crocheted stitch. Strain a thread (photo 1a).
- 3. Insert a needle from the front to the back in a back loop of the last crocheted stitch in a row (photo 2a). Again strain a thread. It is ready! (photos 3a, 4a).


ACCURATE CHANGING OF THE COLORS

I think all the needlewomen want to make the changing of the colors in the course of crocheting less visible.

With the help of the technique which is described at this page you do not remove this changing at all, but you can make it more smooth and organic. If you want, you can use this technique of changing the color while crocheting any detail and any toy.

Step-by-step process:

- 1. In the end of the row (after which it is necessary to change the color) crochet 1 sl st in the last stitch, and 1 more sl st in the first stitch of the next row. Cut the yarn. Thus you have 2 sl st one after another (photo 5a).
- 2. Take the yarn of a new color, take out a loop from the first sl st (the last one in a row) (photo 6a), crochet 1 ch (photo 7a), crochet 1 sc from the second sl st (the first one in a new row) (photo 8a).
- 3. You can fasten off a thread of an old color in the course of crocheting of the next stitches, crocheting it together with the stitches, which you grasp (photo 9a).
- 4. Crochet a row according to the description of crocheting of a detail, crochet the last sc of a row in the very same first sl st, where in the beginning we attached a yarn (photos 10a, 11a).
 - 5. The ready changing is shown at the photo 12a.









THE LIST OF MATERIALS AND TOOLS

This list contains the materials used to make the presented toys. You can use other materials at your discretion.

Yarn:

For the crocheting of the giraffe you can use any smooth yarn of any structure, any thickness and color. All the details, clothes and accessories of the giraffe are crocheted with a yarn of the same thickness. For the sweater you can use a mélange, tweed or monochrome yarn, for example, you can make a striped sweater. Used yarn: (Sport/5ply or DK/8 ply).

Giraffe Theodor:

- YarnArt Jeans №67, light-yellow (there is a new and old color according to this number. I used an old one. For the comparison at the photo there are both colors a new lemon color is from above) for the body and head;
- YarnArt Jeans №40, brown jeans for the horns and hooves;
- Alize Cotton Gold №262, honey for the ears and muzzle;
- Himalaya Denim №115-23, blue for the sweater and collar.

Giraffe Emma:

- Alize Cotton Gold №67, beige for the body and head;
- YarnArt Jeans №40, brown jeans for the horns and hooves;
- YarnArt Jeans №71, cocoa for the ears and muzzle;
- Himalaya Denim №115-24, terracotta (coral) for the sweater and collar;
- Alize Cotton Gold № 385, olive for the skirt and hat;
- Alize Cotton Gold № 493, brown for the skirt, hat and bag;
- Alize Cotton Gold № 647, dry rose for the hat;
- YarnArt Jeans № 03, milky for the bag.

Indications of the colors of the yarn

Color A – the main color of the body, legs, arms and head

Color B – horns and the hooves at the arms and legs

Color C - ears and muzzle

Color D - sweater and collar

Color E - skirt, a stripe on the hat

Color F – border and the belt of the skirt, border and a stripe on the hat, border and a handle of the bag

Color G - hat

Color H - bag

Tools

- the hook № 1,5 (B/1) or of the other size, matching for your yarn;
- a gobelin needle with a blunt end for sewing of the details;
- a thin needle with a wide eye for embroidering;
- eyes. I used the safety eyes Ø 8 mm (0.31"). You can choose the other eyes round beads, sewing plastic halfbeads, also you can crochet or embroider eyes;
- thin black thread for embroidering of lashes and brows;
- white thread for embroidering the pattern at the sweater (optional);
- buttons for the sweater and bag (optional).
- pins for attaching of the details to the body;
- scissors;
- stuffing (hollofayber).



NOTES:















HORNS

Crochet with a yarn of the color B. Crochet MR or 2 ch.

1 rnd: 6 sc (6 st) 2 rnd: 6 inc (12 st)

3-5 rnd: 3 rows - 12 sc in each row (12 st)

6 rnd: 2 sc, dec, 4 sc, dec, 2 sc (10 st)

7 rnd: 10 sc (10 st)

Slightly stuff the horn.

8 rnd: (3 sc, dec)*2 times (8 st)

9 rnd: 8 sc (8 st)



Fold in half and crochet for the both sides 3 sc, crochet 1 sl st in a stitch at the flank of a detail (photo 1). Tighten a loop, cut a thread, leaving enough thread for sewing (photo 2). If you crochet in the horns in the course of crocheting of the head, then hide a thread inside the detail: stretch a thread between the stitches of the last row, step one stitch at the side, stretch through the stitches of the last row in the opposite direction. Step one more stitch, and stretch a thread to the base of the horn. Cut the yarn. It is ready! (photos 3-7).

EARS

Crochet with a yarn of the color C. Crochet MR or 2 ch.

1 rnd: 6 sc (6 st)

2 rnd: inc, 5 sc (7 st)

3 rnd: 1 sc, inc, 5 sc (8 st)


4 rnd: 1 sc, 2 inc, 5 sc (10 st) 5 rnd: 2 sc, 3 inc, 5 sc (13 st)

6-7 rnd: 2 rows - 13 sc in each row (13 st)

8 rnd: 4 sc, 2 dec, 5 sc (11 st) 9 rnd: 2 sc, 3 dec, 3 sc (8 st)

Slightly stuff the ear. For the second ear (right) crochet in the last row for 4 sc more, to keep your ears symmetrical. Fold in half and crochet for the both sides 3 sc, crochet 1 sl st in a stitch at the flank of a detail (as for the horns). Tighten a loop, cut a thread, leaving enough thread for sewing. If you crochet in the ears in the course of crocheting of the head, then hide a thread inside the detail, as for the horns. It is ready! (photo 8).





ATTENTION!

If you crochet in the horns and ears in the course of crocheting of the head, it is necessary to apply them by the right side to the head, by the wrong side to yourself. The right side of the detail corresponds to the right side of the row, with which you closed the detail, crocheting it for the both edges (photos 9-11).







HEAD

Crochet with a yarn of the color C. Crochet chain 6 ch.

1 rnd: (from the second loop from the hook) inc, 3 sc, inc, go to the second side of the chain, in the very same loop - inc, 3 sc, inc (14 st)

2 rnd: 2 inc, 4 sc, 3 inc, 4 sc, inc (20 st)

3 rnd: inc, 1 sc, inc, 5 sc, inc, (1 sc, inc)*2 times, 5 sc, inc, 1 sc (26 st)

4 rnd: (2 sc, inc, 9 sc, inc)*2 times (30 st)

5 rnd: (3 sc, inc, 10 sc, inc)*2 times (34 st)

6 rnd: (4 sc, inc, 11 sc, inc)*2 times (38 st)

7 rnd: 4 sc, inc, 12 sc, inc, 5 sc, inc, 12 sc, inc, 1 sc (42 st)

8 rnd: 5 sc, inc, 13 sc, inc, 6 sc, inc, 13 sc, inc, 1 sc (46 st)

9-12 rnd: 4 rows - 46 sc in each row (46 st)

13 rnd: 8 sc, dec, 9 sc, dec, 10 sc, dec, 9 sc, dec, 2 sc (42 st)

14 rnd: (dec, 5 sc)*5 times, change the yarn to the color A (photo 12), dec, 5 sc (36 st)

15-19 rnd: 5 rows - 36 sc in each row (36 st)

If you use the safety eyes, it's time to attach them. I use the eyes 8 mm (0.31") in diameter, they are inserted between the 15th and the 16th rows.

The space between the eyes is 7 stitches. (photos 13-14).

20-23 rnd: 4 rows - 36 sc in each row (36 st)

Stuff the head. In the next row it is necessary to crochet in the ears and horns, if you've chosen this variant (see the page 10).

















24 rnd: to crochet in the ears and horns symmetrically relatively to the head, it is necessary to check their symmetry.

Crochet 3 sc, insert a pin between the 3rd and the 4th stitches of the row, count out 21 stitch forward along the row, insert the second pin (photo 15). These are the places where will be the lower edges of the ears. Make sure that these points are symmetrical relatively to the muzzle and eyes. If it is not so, crochet more stitches or undo 1-2 sc.

Now you can continue. Crochet in the left ear – apply it by its right side to the head, by the wrong side to yourself (photo 16), and crochet together 3 sc of the ear and the head (photo 17), further 3 sc along the row, crochet in the horn (by its right side to the head) – crochet together 3 sc of the horn and the head (photo 18), further 3 sc along the row, crochet in the second horn with the help of 3 sc, 3 sc along the row, crochet in the right ear with the help of 3 sc, 12 sc along the row (+/- 1-2 sc, if you correct the number of sc in the beginning of the row for the symmetry) (36 st)

At the photos 19-21 is shown how look the crocheted in details and the parts while crocheting in the details.

NOTES:











If you do not want to crochet in the details, and you want to sew the horns and ears separately, then crochet the 24th row as follows: 36 sc (36 st)

Next, continue on the description:

25 rnd: 36 sc (36 st)

26 rnd: 2 sc, dec, (4 sc, dec)*5 times, 2 sc (30 st)

27 rnd: (3 sc, dec)*6 times (24 st)

28 rnd: 1 sc, dec, (2 sc, dec)*5 times, 1 sc (18 st)

Stuff the head completely.

29 rnd: (1 sc, dec)*6 times (12 st)



Tighten the left 12 stitches for the front loops only, hide the thread (photo 21). The head of the giraffe without crocheting in the details - photos 22-23.

ASSEMBLY



ATTENTION! If you crochet Emma, then the places of the horns and ears on the head should coincide with the openings for them in the hat. That's why sew the ears and horns, if you have not crocheted them in, strictly between the 23rd and the 24th rows (photo 24). The spaces between all the horns and ears - 3 stitches between each horn and ear (photo 25).

Embroider the lashes and brows with the thin black thread, embroider the nostrils with the yarn of color A or B (photo 25).

LEGS

Crochet with a yarn of the color B. Crochet MR or 2 ch.

1 rnd: 7 sc (7 st) 2 rnd: 7 inc (14 st)

3 rnd: (1 sc, inc)*7 times (21 st)

4 rnd: 1 sc, inc, (2 sc, inc)*6 times, 1 sc (28 st)

5 rnd: (for the back loops only) 28 sc (28 st)

6 rnd: (for the both loops) 28 sc (28 st)

Change the yarn to the color A.

7 rnd: 6 sc, dec, 12 sc, dec, 6 sc (26 st)

8 rnd: (11 sc, dec)*2 times (24 st)

9 rnd: 5 sc, dec, 10 sc, dec, 5 sc (22 st)

10 rnd: 22 sc (22 st)

11 rnd: (9 sc, dec)*2 times (20 st)

12 rnd: 20 sc (20 st)

13 rnd: 4 sc, dec, 8 sc, dec, 4 sc (18 st)

14 rnd: 18 sc (18 st) Stuff your leg tightly.

15 rnd: (7 sc, dec)*2 times (16 st)

16 rnd: 16 sc (16 st)

17 rnd: 3 sc, dec, 6 sc, dec, 3 sc (14 st)

18-33 rnd: 16 rows - 14 sc in each row (14 st)

In the course of crocheting stuff the leg for 2/3 of its length.

34 rnd: (5 sc, dec)*2 times (12 st)

35-38 rnd: 4 rows - 12 sc in each row (12 st)

Fold the top of the leg in two, so as the changing of the colors at the hoof appeared to be at the side of the leg, at the flank of the bend (photo 26). If it is necessary crochet several more stitches or undo 1-3 sc till the edge of the bend and crochet for the both sides 5 sc, 1 sl st in the flank of the detail (as you did for the horns). Tighten a loop, leave a long thread enough for sewing. If you crochet in the legs in the body, then hide a thread inside the detail, as you did for the horns.

For the second leg crochet in the last row for 6 sc more or less, so as the changing of the colors at the hoof appeared to be at the other edge of the bend, not at the same edge as for the first leg. It is necessary for the symmetry of the details. In that case these changings of the colors will be at the back while crocheting in or sewing of the details (photo 27).















NOTES:



Sole of the hoof

Crochet with a yarn of the color B. Crochet MR or 2 ch.

1 rnd: 7 sc (7 st) 2 rnd: 7 inc (14 st)

3 rnd: (1 sc, inc)*7 times (21 st)

4 rnd: 1 sc, inc, (2 sc, inc)*6 times, 1 sc (28 st)

The ready detail is at the photo 28. Do not cut the yarn, continue crocheting. Apply the sole to the lower part of the leg, it is necessary to crochet them together, beginning from the last free halfloop of the hoof in the row (photo 29). Crochet 28 sl st together for the both halfloops of the sole and the left front loops of the lower part of the leg. Crochet 1 sl st + 1 fst sl st. Hide the thread. It is ready! (photos 30-33).



ARMS

Crochet with a yarn of the color B. Crochet MR or 2 ch.

1 rnd: 6 sc (6 st)

2 rnd: 6 inc (12 st)

3 rnd: (inc, 1 sc)*5 times, inc, 1 sl st (18 st)

4 rnd: (for the back loops only) 18 sc (18 st)

Change the yarn to the color A.

5 rnd: (for the both loops) 18 sc (18 st)

6 rnd: (7 sc, dec)*2 times (16 st)

7 rnd: 3 sc, dec, 6 sc, dec, 3 sc (14 st)

Crochet +1 shift stitch, move the marker.

8 rnd: 14 sc (14 st)

Change the yarn to the color D.

9 rnd: (5 sc, dec)*2 times (12 st)

10 rnd: 12 sc (12 st)

11 rnd: 2 sc, dec, 4 sc, dec, 2 sc (10 st)

Stuff the arm.

12-33 rnd: 22 rows - 10 sc in each row (10 st)

In the course of crocheting stuff the arm for 2/3 of its length. Fold the top of the arm in two, so as the changing of the colors at the hoof appeared to be at the side of the arm, at the flank of the bend (photo 34). If it is necessary crochet several more stitches or undo 1-3 sc till the edge of the bend and crochet for the both sides 4 sc, 1 sl st in the flank of the detail (as you did for the horns). Tighten a loop, leave a long thread enough for sewing. If you crochet in the arms in the body, then hide a thread inside the detail, as you did for the horns.

For the second arm crochet in the last row for 5 sc more or less, so as the changing of the colors at the hoof appeared to be at the other edge of the bend, not at the same edge as for the first arm. It is necessary for the symmetry of the details. (photo 34). Decorate the sole of the hoof. To do this take a yarn of the color B. Turn the arm by the lower side to yourself, crochet 18 sl st for the left not crocheted halfloops along the bottom of the arm, beginning from the last free halfloop of the hoof in the row (photo 35-36).

Crochet 1 sl st + 1 fst sl st. Hide the thread (photos 37-38).





















BODY

Crochet with a yarn of the color A. Crochet MR or 2 ch.

1 rnd: 6 sc (6 st) 2 rnd: 6 inc (12 st)

3 rnd: (1 sc, inc)*6 times (18 st)

4 rnd: 1 sc, inc, (2 sc, inc)*5 times, 1 sc (24 st)

5 rnd: (3 sc, inc)*6 times (30 st)

6 rnd: 2 sc, inc, (4 sc, inc)*5 times, 2 sc (36 st)

7 rnd: (5 sc, inc)*6 times (42 st)

8 rnd: 3 sc, inc, (6 sc, inc)*5 times, 3 sc (48 st)

9 rnd: (7 sc, inc)*6 times (54 st)

10 rnd: 54 sc (54 st) (photo 39)

In the next row it is necessary to crochet in the legs, if you've chosen this variant (photos 40-43).

11 rnd: 10 sc, crochet in the left leg with the help of 5 sc, 22 sc along the row, crochet in the right leg with the help of 5 sc, 12 sc along the row (54 st) If you do not want to crochet in the legs, and you want to sew the legs separately, then crochet the 11th row as follows: 54 sc (54 st)

12-14 rnd: 3 rows - 54 sc in each row (54 st)
Change the yarn to the color D.

15-18 rnd: 4 rows - 54 sc in each row (54 st)

19 rnd: (25 sc, dec)*2 times (52 st)

20 rnd: 12 sc, dec, 24 sc, dec, 12 sc (50 st)

21 rnd: (23 sc, dec)*2 times (48 st)

22 rnd: 7 sc, dec, (14 sc, dec)*2 times, 7 sc (45 st)

23 rnd: (13 sc, dec)*3 times (42 st) Stuff the body.

24 rnd: 6 sc, dec, (12 sc, dec)*2 times, 6 sc (39 st)

25 rnd: (11 sc, dec)*3 times (36 st)

26 rnd: 8 sc, dec, 16 sc, dec, 8 sc (34 st)

27 rnd: (15 sc, dec)*2 times (32 st)

28 rnd: 7 sc, dec, 14 sc, dec, 7 sc (30 st)

29 rnd: (13 sc, dec)*2 times (28 st)

30 rnd: 6 sc, dec, 12 sc, dec, 6 sc (26 st)

31-32 rnd: 2 rows - 26 sc in each row (26 st)







In the next row it is necessary to crochet in the arms, if you've chosen this variant (photos 44-46).

33 rnd: crochet 9 sc, apply the arm and check if it is at one and the same level with the crocheted in leg (photos 44, 46). If it is not so, crochet more stitches or undo 1-2 sc. Crochet in the left arm with the help of 4 sc, 9 sc along the row, crochet in the right arm with the help of 4 sc. If you increased the number of sc in the beginning of the row, then the last sc with the crocheted in arm go to the first stitches of the next row (in this case just crochet in the 34th row as many sc less, as you've crocheted before, do not move the marker). If you decreased the number of sc in the beginning of the row, crochet this number of sc to the end of the current row (number of the crocheted stitches in the 33rd row - 26 st).

If you do not want to crochet in the arms, and you want to sew the arms separately, then crochet

the 33rd row as follows: 26 sc (26 st)

34-35 rnd: 2 rows - 26 sc in each row (26 st)

Stuff the body.

Change the yarn to the color A.

36-38 rnd: 3 rows - 26 sc (26 st)

39 rnd: (11 sc, dec)*2 times (24 st)

40-42 rnd: 3 rows - 24 sc in each row (24 st)

43 rnd: 5 sc, dec, 10 sc, dec, 5 sc (22 st)

44-46 rnd: 3 rows - 22 sc in each row (22 st)

Stuff the neck.

47 rnd: (9 sc, dec)*2 times (20 st)

48-50 rnd: 3 rows - 20 sc in each row (20 st)



Now it is necessary to make a small raising at one side of the neck for the slope of the head.

51 rnd: crochet 11 sc, 1 sl st. This slip stitch should be directly at the side of the neck, if you fold it in half, so as the arms of the giraffe will be placed symmetrically at the bends of the neck (photos 47-48). If it is not so, crochet more stitches or undo 1-2 sc, again crochet 1 sl st. Crochet 1 ch, turn the crocheting. From the second loop from the hook crochet 1 sl st, 8 sc, 1 sl st, 1 ch, turn the crocheting (photo 49). From the second loop from the hook crochet 1 sl st, 9 sc along the raising + 8 sc along the main row (20 st) (photos 50-52)

52 rnd: 2 sc along the main row, 10 sc along the raising, 1 sc along the main row, 1 sl st (20 st) (photo 53)

Tighten a loop, cut a thread, leaving enough thread for sewing. Stuff the neck completely. It is ready! (photos 54-55).

















NOTES:



ASSEMBLY AND DECORATION

If you have not crocheted in the legs and arms, then sew them. Sew the legs at the level of the 11th row, the arms – at the level of the 33rd row.

Sew the head

Attach the neck of the giraffe to the head with pins. The raising of the neck should be at the back, and its front part should join to the changing of the colors on the head (photo 56-57). I recommend to take more pins and attach the neck as equally as possible.

Sew the neck, cut and hide the thread (photo 57).

Collar of the sweater

Crochet with a yarn of the color D in back-and-forth rows for the both halfloops. In the end of each row crochet 1 ch and turn the crocheting.

Crochet chain 6 ch.

1 row: from the second loop from the hook crochet 5 sc, 1 ch, turn the crocheting (5 st, this ch is not included in the number of stitches)

2 row: 5 sc, 1 ch, turn the crocheting (5 st)

Crochet 120-130 more rows in this way, so as you can freely wind the collar 3 times around the neck. In the end of the last row crochet 1 ch. Tighten a loop, cut a thread, leaving enough thread for sewing. Tighten a loop (photo 58).

Wind the collar 3 times round the neck, as you like, you can twist it a couple of times. Sew the edges of the collar together at the back (photo 59).

Straighten the collar, give it a desirable shape. Sew the collar to the neck in several places by invisible stitches, so as it does not

slip down and does not lose its shape. Sew a button to the collar with a thread of the color D slightly moving it to the side. It is ready! (photo 60).














Tail

Take a yarn of the color A, cut three pieces of a thread 20 cm (7.87") long each one (photo 61). Stretch all three threads in the center of the body in the place of changing the colors, grasping 2 stitches in the width (photos 62-63). So you get 6 threads. Divide them in three parts, 2 threads in each part (photo 64). Make a strong braid 3 cm (1.18") long (photo 65). Make a strong knot at the end of this braid with the help of all the threads, tighten it well (photo 66). Cut the threads at the space 1,5 cm (0.59)" from a knot. Fluff up the ends of the threads with a needle, so as you get a switch at the tail (photo 67). It is ready! (photo 68).











SKIRT

Crochet with a yarn of the color E in circular rows, but not in a spiral, but with the connection of the end and beginning of each row in a circle with 1 sl st.

Crochet chain 63 ch. Connect the chain in a ring with the help of 1 sl st.

1 rnd: 62 sc, 1 sl st (close the row) (62 st) (photo 71)

2 rnd: 1 ch, 62 inc, 1 sl st (124 st) 3 rnd: 2 ch, 124 hdc, 1 sl st (124 st) 4 rnd: 2 ch, 124 dc, 1 sl st (124 st)

Further alternate the rows – one row of sc, one row of hdc, one row of dc.

5 rnd: 1 ch, 124 sc, 1 sl st (124 st)

6 rnd: 2 ch, 124 hdc, 1 sl st (124 st)

7 rnd: 2 ch, 124 dc, 1 sl st (124 st)

8 rnd: 1 ch, 124 sc, 1 sl st (124 st)

9 rnd: 2 ch, 124 hdc, 1 sl st (124 st)

10 rnd: 2 ch, 124 dc, 1 sl st (124 st)

11 rnd: 1 ch, 124 sc, 1 sl st (124 st)

(photo 72). Change the yarn to the color F.

12 rnd: 1 ch, 124 sc, 1 sl st (124 st)

13 rnd: crochet 124 sl st along the row (124 st)
Make 1 fst sl st, cut and hide the thread (photo 73).

Now it is necessary to crochet the belt of the skirt. Crochet with a yarn of the color F in circular rows (with sl st in the end of each row).

1 rnd: take out a loop in the place of the connection in a circle of the 1st row. Crochet 1 ch, crochet along the free halfloops of the chain 62 sc, 1 sl st – connecting the row in a circle (62 st) (photo 74)

2-3 rnd: 2 rows - 1 ch, 62 sc, 1 sl st - in each row (62 st)

4 rnd: crochet 62 sl st along the row (62 st)

Make 1 fst sl st, cut and hide the thread. The skirt is ready! (photo 75). You can sew it, or you can leave it removable.











HAT

Crochet with a yarn of the color G. Crochet MR or 2 ch.

1 rnd: 6 sc (6 st) 2 rnd: 6 inc (12 st)

3 rnd: (1 sc, inc)*6 times (18 st)

4 rnd: 1 sc, inc, (2 sc, inc)*5 times, 1 sc (24 st)

5 rnd: (3 sc, inc)*6 times (30 st)

6 rnd: 2 sc, inc, (4 sc, inc)*5 times, 2 sc (36 st)

7 rnd: (8 sc, inc)*4 times (40 st)

8 rnd: 40 sc (40 st)

In the next row form 4 openings in the hat

9 rnd: 5 sc, (crochet chain 7 ch, skip 5 stitches



for the horns and ears.

of the row, beginning from the 6th stitch of the row crochet 3 sc)*4 times, 3 sc (48 st) (photos 76-78) 10 rnd: 5 sc along the row, (7 sc for the back loops of the chain, 3 sc along the row)*4 times, 3 sc (48 st)

(photos 79-80) Change the yarn to the color E.


11 rnd: 48 sc (48 st)

Change the yarn to the color F.

12 rnd: 48 sc (48 st) Change the yarn to the color G.

13 rnd: (for the front loops only) (11 sc, inc)*4 times (52 st) (photo 81)















14 rnd: (for the both loops) 6 sc, inc, (12 sc, inc)*3 times, 6 sc (56 st)

15 rnd: (13 sc, inc)*3 times, 14 sc (59 st)

Crochet 1 sl st, cut the yarn.

Attach a yarn of the color F in the beginning of the row. Crochet 59 sl st along the row (photo 82). Make 1 fst sl st, cut and hide the thread (photo 83).

The hat is ready! You can give different shapes to the hat thanks to its brim, so you can change Emma's image (photos 84-85).

NOTES:

BAG

Crochet with a yarn of the color H in back-and-forth rows for the both halfloops. In the end of each row crochet 1 ch and turn the crocheting. Crochet chain 13 ch.

1 row: (from the second loop from the hook) 12 sc (12 st)

2-21 row: 20 rows - 12 sc in each row (12 st)

22 row: 1 sc, dec, 3 inc dc, dec, 4 sc (13 st)

23 row: 3 sc, dec, 1 dc, inc dc, 2 dc, inc dc, 1 dc, 1 sc, 1 sl st (14 st)

Cut and hide the thread (photo 86).






Border of the bag
Count out 9 rows from
the beginning of crocheting,
and fold the detail in half,
by the wrong side inside
(so as the right part of the first
row appeared to be outside)
(photo 87).























Now it is necessary to crochet round the edge of the bag with yarn of the color F. Begin from the edge of the bottom, turning the detail by the bigger part to yourself (photo 88). Insert the hook through the both halves of the detail in the lower corner, take out a loop, further insert the hook over 1 row, crochet the first sl st (photo 88), further along the lateral side crochet 7 more sl st through the both halves till the edge of the right part of the detail (photo 89). Crochet chain 6 ch, 1 sl st in the very same stitch – so we get a loop for the handle (photo 90), further 4 sl st along the lateral part, 14 sl st along the top of the detail, 4 sl st along the lateral part, 1 sl st through the both halves of the detail, crochet chain 6 ch, 1 sl st in the very same stitch, 8 more sl st along the lateral part for the both halves, 11 sl st along the bottom (photo 91).

Cut the yarn and hide the end of a thread. Slightly stuff the bag (photo 92). Bend the cover of the bag, sew by a couple of stitches, or sew a button (photo 93).

Handle. Crochet chain 71 ch with a yarn of the color F. From the second loop from the hook crochet along the chain 69 sc, 1 sl st. Cut the yarn, leave a small piece for sewing of the handle. Tighten a loop. Stretch the handle through the loops of the bag, sew, fasten off and hide the end (photos 94-95). The bag is ready! You can carry on the shoulder, or you can pull and fold the handle in half (photos 96-97). In this case you get the bag with a short handle, which you can give in Emma's arms:)

Congratulations, the toy is ready!
