OPERATION "MOSES" - Serbia "becomes" the new Israel

Plans to relocate the population and institutions of the State of Israel have emerged on the international diplomatic scene in the event that Islamic terrorists win the war with America.

World analysts claim that in the next fifty years, Serbia will become an ideal place for the creation of a new Jewish state.

The latest political, military and economic initiatives speak in favor of this claim.

THE FALL OF ISRAEL!

We are only a decade away from marking a century of intolerance and conflict between Arabs and Jews over the most controversial state in the world – Israel.

The capital of Israel, Jerusalem is a historic location that is the cradle and holy site of Islam, Christianity, and Judaism, the three most influential world religions.

After two thousand years, Jerusalem once again became the capital of Israel, but only after the "Seven Day War", when it was occupied in a Jewish counteroffensive against Jordanian forces.

In the catastrophic defeat of the countries that waged war against Israel, in addition to heavy losses in manpower and equipment, some also lost parts of their territory, such as Syria, which lost the Golan Heights.

Enjoying the support of the US, Israel ignored UN demands for the return of the territories, building military fortifications and ethnically pure Jewish settlements on them.

Apart from relations with its neighbors, the main problem of this "biblical state" is the issue of the Palestinian nation, the Arab indigenous people.

During the creation of Israel, hundreds of thousands of Palestinians were expelled to surrounding Arab states and refugee camps.

Israeli crimes led to armed resistance led by the Palestine Liberation Organization (PLO) led by Yasser Arafat.

Although in the most difficult moments of its struggle, the PLO sometimes resorted to classic terrorism, in which innocents were often killed (as at the

Rome airport), together with Che Guevara, Arafat became one of the main symbols of resistance and the fight for freedom in the twentieth century.

The change in the world political scene after the collapse of the Soviet Union contributed to even Arab states withholding support for the Palestinian resistance.

The Americans sought recognition of Israel, and the Arabs demanded a solution to the Palestinian issue.

Under pressure from both sides, a compromise solution was found in the creation of Palestinian autonomous areas in the Gaza Strip and the West Bank.

The Palestinian "Intifada" has ended, and the Israeli army has withdrawn.

Although a solution seemed to be on the horizon, the peace did not last long.

The diplomatically ill-advised move of Yasser Arafat, who supported Iraq in the Gulf War, gave Israel the green light to launch a final showdown with the Palestinian state.

Since then, Israel has openly practiced ethnic cleansing, attacked civilian and refugee settlements, carried out assassinations and kidnappings, raids and combat operations in Palestinian territory.

These actions have sparked a new cycle of unprecedented violence and the strengthening of Islamist Palestinian terrorist groups.

The renewed war in Palestine has been used as the main argument in the fight of Islamic terrorists against the Western world, from Hamas and

Hezbollah to Al Qaeda and Gama Islamia. America and Israel are waging a "global war on terrorism", actually against the aforementioned terrorist organizations, but its outcome is uncertain.

That is why the "Moses" plan was created, to relocate the population and institutions of Israel in the event of Islamic terrorism winning the war with America.

ANTISEMITISM AND SERBIA!

During the Cold War, the world also took opposing positions on the issue of Israel.

Our country, the leader of the world's "third party" in the form of the Non-Aligned Movement, advocated the position that "Israel is an artificial creation created by the will of great powers through the use of force and injustice", which enabled it to play an important diplomatic and economic role in the Middle East.

Countless business arrangements, concessions to oil fields, exports of experts, technology, but also military equipment and weapons spoke in favor of the profitable stance of non-recognition of Israel.

In addition to cooperating with Arab states, the SFRY provided diplomatic, military, and logistical assistance to the PLO and Yasser Arafat.

Military and intelligence training of Palestinian freedom fighters was conducted in training camps on the territory of Yugoslavia, but also in Arab countries.

The peak of this cooperation was when the SFRY received wounded PLO fighters after the Israeli aggression and occupation of Lebanon.

Scenes of the wounded waving our flags and carrying Tito's pictures as they were taken out of the plane evoked undivided sympathy for the PLO struggle to this day.

However, times have changed.

With the disappearance of the USSR and the beginning of the disintegration of the SFRY, our state leadership also recognized the existence of the state of Israel, following the example of the Arab states.

All aid to the PLO was cut off, only the informal embassy of the Palestinian Authority in Belgrade was maintained.

It is important to note that during the entire time that the official policy of the SFRY was on the side of the PLO and the Arab world, there was no anti-Semitism in Yugoslavia.

Jews have lived in our region for more than 400 years, since their expulsion from Spain and Portugal in the 14th century.

A large number of Jews found refuge in the auspices of Spain's fiercest opponent at the time - Turkey.

Jews then came in large numbers to Serbia, Bosnia and Macedonia.

For four centuries, Jews were equal participants in the life of the Serbian state.

Some of the great representatives of Serbian culture and intelligentsia were Jews.

Writers Oskar Davičo, Danilo Kiš, Aleksandar Tišma, painters Oskar Herman, Leon Cohen, Ivo Rajn, but also scientists such as Gavro Švarc, Lavoslav Šik, Zvonimir Rihman, Mirko Brejer and others.

By the beginning of World War II, over 60,000 Jews lived in the Kingdom of Yugoslavia, but only 15,000 survived the Nazi terror.

Between 1948 and 1952, 8,000 local Jews moved to Israel.

According to the 1991 census, about 3,000 Jews remained in FR Yugoslavia.

There are 513 registered Jews in Vojvodina, which makes up 0.02% of the total population.

More than 100 members of this nation live in Novi Sad alone.

DAVID AGAINST GOLIATH

The idea of displacing populations and institutions in the event of the collapse of the Jewish state dates back to the first Arab-Israeli war.

During the Cold War, Israel was aware that its survival was tied to the fate of America and Britain.

Without American support, Israel would have disappeared despite the heavy losses suffered by the united Arab army.

The Israeli leadership was in a dilemma about how to defend the state that had been re-established after so many years.

Operation "David" is the code name for Israel's first defense solution.

The name of the operation was taken from the Old Testament tradition - David was supposed to symbolize Israel in the fight against Goliath, who represented the Arab world and the USSR.

Operation David represented the classic defense of borders and territories, at all costs.

For this purpose, America was requested to provide technology for the production of atomic weapons.

Since the US was not the most confident in Jewish cold-bloodedness, this technology only came to Israel in the 1970s.

After two war victories, the Americans assessed that the Jews were mature enough to manage the situation in the event of a third Arab-Israeli war.

Wanting to rely as much as possible on its own resources to defend the country in the event of a US defeat, Israel also developed its own military industry.

Israeli Military Industries – IMI has developed the production of all types of weapons, from classic to the most modern combat systems.

Although it does not admit to possessing nuclear weapons, Israel has repeatedly threatened to use these weapons in the event of a new attack on their country.

Operation Moses represents another option for displacing the population of Israel.

There is a clear association with the story from the Old Testament in which

Moses led the people of Israel out of Egypt by opening a passage through the

Red Sea leading them to the promised land.

This plan was not supported by the fact that the defeat of the USA would mean the disappearance of Western Europe, and these were precisely the alternative destinations of the new Israel.

At that time, new independent states were being created in Africa, South America was shaking from the Cuban revolution, Asia and Australia felt the threat of Red China, which would sweep away the puppet regimes in an onslaught, so that there would be no room there to build a new Jerusalem either.

ESCAPE TO EUROPE!!!

With the end of the threat of nuclear war and the adoption of a new US global strategy, Operation Moses came to the forefront.

Since they were aware of the US plan, which wanted to appropriate 80% of the world's oil reserves in the next thirty years, by occupying Syria, Libya, Iraq, Iran..., the Israelis predicted the strengthening of Islamic terrorism and a clash of civilizations on a global scale.

Unlike the Cold War scenarios, in this case, humanity would not entirely fall under the rule of one option, but rather, in the new division of the world, there would be several separate and mutually isolated entities.

The analytical service of the Mossad (Israeli counterintelligence service) was to produce a detailed analysis for the selection of a new country, taking into account the following requirements:

- the future territory of Israel must be a state with no history of anti-Semitism, i.e., it must not be home to strong anti-Semitic movements and parties;
- it must not be a national but, above all, a multicultural civic state;
- the majority population must not be of Islamic faith;
- the territory of the state must be a compact entity with defined borders;
- membership in political and military Euro-Atlantic organizations is desirable;
- the state must have access to a significant sea and basic infrastructure;
- the number of inhabitants should not exceed 10 million;
- the economic system must be an open capitalist economy with a large percentage of foreign capital;
- before the evacuation begins, the Israeli state and its citizens should own
 25% of the economy and land of the selected country.

The choice was narrowed down to the European continent and the Russian Federation, because, in the opinion of the Mossad, Africa and Asia are permanently unstable areas where great powers would not tolerate the creation of new states.

On the other hand, in case of defeat, the North American states and Australia would fall into an economic and political crisis, and the countries of South America also fell, due to revolutionary turmoil and civil and local conflicts.

Due to the size of the Russian Federation and the uninhabited nature of certain areas, an offer to purchase the territory was considered.

Boris Yeltsin was in power at the time, and for a certain amount of money and under strong pressure, he would have agreed to such an offer.

However, the Jews declined this offer since anti-Semitism is endemic in Russia – it existed under both the Tsars and the Communists.

Under such conditions, new conflicts would be more likely, certainly not a new Israel.

Like Russia, Europe had an anti-Semitic past.

From Spain in the 14th century to Germany and its allies in World War II, almost all countries in Western and Eastern Europe have had at least one major persecution of Jews in their history.

In addition, European states are in most cases states with a national character, and the creation of sovereign Jewish entities would lead to new conflicts and the final end of the road for the tribe of Moses.

SERBIA - THE LAST REFUGE !!!

With the emergence of new states in Europe, the idea emerged of influencing current developments on the ground with the aim of changing the borders and ethnic structure of selected states, thereby fulfilling the aforementioned requirements within a certain period of time.

In a detailed analysis of the former republics of the SFRY, the Republic of Serbia emerged as a candidate that, with possible tweaks, could be the ideal choice for the new Israel.

The reasons are as follows:

- anti-Semitism among Serbs is incomparably milder than in other Balkan countries;
- According to the Constitution, but also in terms of the number of national minorities, Serbia is a civil, not a national, state;
- the majority population is Christian and the Islamic part is isolated, which was formalized in later events in the form of the occupation of Kosovo and Metohija;
- Serbia is compact, its borders with its neighbors date back to World War I,
 and the borders with the breakaway republics would be defined later, which
 was the case with the Dayton Agreement;
- Even before October 5th, there was a tendency in Serbia to move towards
 Euro-Atlantic integration, and with the October 5th coup, practical
 implementation began;

- access to the sea, even in the event of the breakup of the union with
 Montenegro, would be ensured via Greece to the Aegean Sea;
- Over time, Serbia has become open to foreign investments.

The last condition, which implied ownership of 25% of real estate, was implemented with the arrival of a government of "economic experts" at the federal and republic levels.

People in those governments were willing to participate in this plan due to economic interest or affiliation with certain intelligence services.

The fact that was particularly relevant to the realization of the Israeli plan was the catastrophic birth rate of the majority people in Serbia.

It has been mathematically proven that in fifty years the Serbs in Serbia will become a minority.

Such a chance was not to be missed.

The Jewish leadership saw God's providence in the vacant position.

Tel Aviv gave the green light for the start of the implementation of the "Moses" operation.

The beginning of Israel's interference in events in the SFRY coincided with the arrival of the democratic administration of Bill Clinton.

The most prominent participants in American policy towards Serbia from the Clinton cabinet were of Jewish origin.

Is it really a coincidence that Jews Madeleine Albright, Richard Holbrooke, James Rubin and Wesley Clark participated in the collapse of the SFRY and in the crimes against Serbia?

In addition to the media that is under the control of Jewish capital, well-known European intellectuals of Jewish origin have also joined this fight, leading the campaign to demonize Serbia.

NOBEL PRIZE LAWYERS AND OLIGARS

Although American Jews particularly stood out in Operation Moses, their European compatriots should not be forgotten.

Elie Wiesel, Nobel Peace Prize laureate, visited Serbia to hear and see the truth about the crimes against the Serbian people on the spot.

After spending almost two weeks in Serbia, Wiesel returned to France with an arsenal of accusations against Serbia and its people.

During his stay, Wiesel's indifference to the testimony of a boy from Gospić whose father and mother were slaughtered by the Ustashas before his eyes was memorable.

Is it a coincidence that the other two most prominent European Serbo-haters were also Jews – right-wing philosopher and publicist Henri Bernard Levy and the notorious Kosovo administrator Bernard Kouchner.

A special place in the alley of Jewish "giants" who contributed to the crisis in the former Yugoslavia and influenced the internal political and media situation in Serbia belongs to the American Jew of Hungarian origin, George Soros.

His organization, the Fund for a Humane and Open Society, is still active in our country.

It was he – together with Russian Jewish oligarchs Boris Berezovsky and Mikhail Khordohovsky – who, during the rule of Boris Yeltsin, was supposed to be the leader of the project to purchase the territories in Russia needed for the creation of a new Israel.

Soros made a similar offer to Serbia last year, proposing the sale of Kosovo and Metohija.

All the mentioned prominent European and American Jews contributed to the realization of the "Moses" plan.

Their decisions and efforts were just part of the activities in the Mossad's strategy of "influencing current events on the ground in order to change the borders and ethnic structure of the selected state."

The second part of the plan was to be carried out on site with the help of people from Serbia.

To remind you: About the violations of the Statute of the Red Cross by Secretary Cica

By wholeheartedly supporting certain opposition political parties of the time, Jewish lobbyists were preparing their own puppets who were planned to take over power in Serbia in the future.

The October 5 coup and the coming to power of the DOS coalition finally "crowned" the long-standing work of the US and Israeli intelligence services.

People who were ready and had previously been informed of the plans to relocate the population and institutions of the state of Israel to Serbian soil finally came to power in Serbia.

FROM EDUCATION TO ECONOMY

The main carriers of this policy were non-governmental organizations whose role was to oversee, direct, and coordinate legal and other projects, through the adoption and implementation of which Serbia was preparing for future Jewish colonization.

Under their own and foreign pressure, the following steps were taken:

- Serbia declared amnesty for thousands of convicted Albanian terrorists
- With the blockade in the work on the new Constitution, Serbia remains the only civil state in Europe whose majority people do not have the right to their own nation-state
- The Federal Republic of Yugoslavia was disbanded with the main goal of dividing the single territory inhabited by the Serbian people.
- A constitutional initiative was launched to regionalize Serbia, dividing it into
 6 autonomous provinces
- In the existing province of Vojvodina, proposals have been put forward for a bicameral provincial assembly in which Serbs would be disproportionately represented and a Constitution of Vojvodina under which Serbs would only be its citizens, while minorities would have their own national sovereignty and identity.

- A falsified history appeared in school textbooks in which NATO aggression
 was called an "action" and was justified by "Serbian stubbornness"
- The Ministry of Education proposed abolishing the Serbian language subject and introducing a spoken language
- Active efforts were made to break up the Serbian Orthodox Church, forcing it to recognize the Pope of Rome while simultaneously supporting priests who advocated a "new ecumenism."

From the period of the struggle against Milosevic, one non-governmental organization differed from others in many ways.

In its image, organization, and operations, it resembled more of a paramilitary formation than a civic initiative.

A high-ranking official of this "people's movement" of Jewish origin was the main figure for cooperation with US structures and the distribution of financial aid received from the US Congress.

After all, it is hard to believe that the similarity between the logo of the militant Jewish Defense League based in the US and the logo of our "spontaneous people's movement" is coincidental.

The domestic logo, with astonishing regularity, appears in places where American national interests are threatened.

It could be seen in Venezuela during the attempt to overthrow President Hugo Chavez and in Georgia when our October 5th scenario was "rewritten" in detail.

The story of Operation "Moses" would not be complete if the extradition of Serbian citizens to the Hague Tribunal was not mentioned.

The indictment for crimes in Kosovo, which resulted in the extradition of the former state and military leadership, was filed by prosecutor Louise Arbour, a Canadian Jew, who replaced the Jew Richard Goldstone in that position.

The current presiding judge of the Hague Tribunal is also an American Jew, Theodore Meron.

At the same time as its legislative activity, the state has also completely surrendered itself economically to investors from Israel.

Realizing the requirement of ownership of a minimum of 25% of the economy and land by the Israeli state and citizens of Israel before the start of colonization, Israeli businessmen and companies flooded Serbia.

One of the most important Israeli businessmen, Yossi Maiman, president of the Merhav Group, had met with the late Prime Minister of Serbia, as well as with the ministers of finance and agriculture.

It is symptomatic that the then Minister of Agriculture, Dragan Veselinov, even before becoming minister, traveled to Israel where he spontaneously discussed the possibility of purchasing Israeli irrigation systems worth 400 million dollars.

On that occasion, the Israelis expressed interest in privatizing the DTD canal network as a strategically important system whose ownership would control almost all food production in Serbia. In light of the "Vojvodina project", the question arises as to why the Government of the Republic of Serbia would finance land irrigation when in its program it announced the privatization and sale of agricultural combines to foreigners who already own the majority of arable land in Vojvodina.

In Israeli circles, there is interest in other areas, primarily in real estate, the food industry, and telecommunications.

- -The company "Astrum" bought several hectares across from Kalemegdan.
- -The company "Europort", in cooperation with the American "Colliers", is purchasing land complexes near the "Surčin" airport.
- -The Levinstein Company and Saul Loten purchased land in the territory of New Belgrade.
- -The companies "Kardan" and "Englel" are interested in purchasing several significant properties in Belgrade.
- -The largest Israeli coffee, chocolate and confectionery concern "Elit" has invested 15 million euros in the purchase of the company "Doncafe".
- -The company "Avital" in southern Serbia bought a chocolate factory.

It is interesting that the minister who visited Israel most often is the former Minister of Defense of Serbia and Montenegro, and now the former President of Serbia, Boris Tadić.

Little is known about his most significant three-day visit to Israel.

In addition to meetings with military and economic officials, Tadić also met with representatives of the Israeli government, as well as the opposition.

Analysts take this unusual rapprochement with the entire political leadership of Israel as confirmation that Operation Moses is a national project of priority importance that unites all relevant political and economic factors in Israel.

In those days, the military minister made statements about strategic cooperation between Serbia and Israel.

The issue of choosing a military technical partner is a strategic issue of national importance because it concerns the national strategic defense.

The Serbian Parliament would have to make a statement on this, because it entails unforeseeable consequences in a political, security, and historical sense.

This choice, of course, places Serbia on America's side in the war against terrorism.

The consequences of such a decision will be visible in future terrorist attacks on our country.

These and similar attacks will be the logical outcome of Serbia's close cooperation with the military and intelligence services of America and Israel.

Prominent military analysts find evidence of the "Israelization" of the Serbian army in the initiative to have the domestic intelligence service trained by the Israeli Mossad, but also in the presence of Israeli officers in the Ministry of Defense in the capacity of special advisors and observers.

Another form of military-technical cooperation, which Tadić loudly announced, is the procurement of equipment and weapons from Israel.

The illogicalities arising from the list of beautiful wishes of the Minister of Defense can only be interpreted in two ways: either it is a matter of conscious participation in Operation "Moses" or it is simple corruption in the form of a financial commission.

In any case, Tadić spontaneously expressed interest in, above all, infantry weapons.

If we exclude the possibility of purchasing or producing the Israeli "Galil" rifle, which is actually a copy of the "Kalashnikov", the only option left is to import the "Tavor".

The production of the "tavor" rifle in Serbia is out of the question because Israel is trying to move the production to the USA, in order to carry out the future rearmament of the US army after the withdrawal of the "M-16" rifle.

The import of "Tavor" rifles into Serbia also poses a question of financial justification.

The price of the domestic rifle "M-21", which is in accordance with NATO standards, is far below the price of the "Tavor", which is 3,500 dollars.

There is also particular interest in the procurement of unmanned aerial vehicles from Israel.

Analysts interpret this acquisition as preparation for participation in future American wars. Tadić has publicly renounced the violent methods used in the 19th century and the use of the army in Kosovo, so the question of the opponent and the space in which they will be used is rightly raised.

Without denying the quality of Israeli aircraft, it is necessary to point out that they are, first and foremost, sophisticated spy equipment.

Let us remind you: Serbia is trying to strengthen its army. But who will it be at war with?

Whether they will be used in espionage against neighboring countries remains to be seen.

As the crowning evidence of the "Israelization" of the Serbian army, military experts point to the modernization of Soviet fighters "MiG-21" and "MiG-29", as well as "MiL-8" helicopters in Israel.

Although there are much more successful and cheaper modernization programs in Russia and Ukraine, which are in line with NATO standards, Tadić arbitrarily decided on a more expensive but also worse option.

A model for a successful and inexpensive modernization of the MiG-21 fighter exists in the Russian MiG-21/93 program.

With this program, India modernized 150 of its MiGs and thus saved money on the purchase of a new squadron of MiG 29 fighters.

Both Boris Tadić and Bill Clinton, great friends of the Israelis, in addition to belonging to parties with the same name, share a pacifist leftist youth, but also a right-wing belligerent "old age" that appears when they are in power. Following the example of his American colleague, who declared that he was ready "to take up arms, to fight and die for the defense of Israel," Boris Tadić decided to put Serbia into the operation of the American-Israeli military machinery, thus taking a significant place in the future Jewish colonization of Serbia.

Whether the rest of Serbia is also ready to agree to the plan for the disappearance of Serbia and the creation of a new Israel on the soil of our country will perhaps be best seen on the day when the followers of Osama Bin Laden address us in their recognizable manner.
