Meaning:A description of someone who is both tall and thinExamples:The model is tall and slim, which is perfect for the runway.
His tall and slim figure made him stand out in the crowd.
People often compliment her on her tall and slim build.

14. bright eyes

Meaning:Eyes that appear lively, expressive, or full of energyExamples:

Her bright eyes revealed her excitement for the trip. Mohsen has bright eyes that light up whenever he talks about his passions. The child's bright eyes sparkled with curiosity.

Meaning: To appear fashionable or trendy Examples: She always looks stylish in whatever she wears. He bought a new jacket to look stylish this winter. Those sunglasses make you look so stylish!
