Sayyed Hassan Nasrallah's recommended religious program + advice based on the Holy Prophet's speech on the beginning of the holy month of Ramadan:

-fasting; postpone travel when possible to gain the bounties of fasting during the holy month

-praying the obligatory prayers on time

-refraining from sleeping before Fajr prayer, which results in missing this prayer

-reciting the Quran calmly, slowly, and with attention, taking the morals and lessons it teaches us; don't stress on finishing it, rather focus on understanding the verses you read well

-trying to finish the Quran at least once is highly recommended; reading one juz' a day does not take much time, and the bounties of reading one verse during this holy month equates reciting the entire Quran in other months

-sending salawat upon the Holy Prophet and his Holy progeny as much as possible; there is no limit

اللهم صل على محمد وأل محمد

-praying some recommended prayers (Nawafil); Salat-ul Layl, Nafilat al-Maghreb, Shafa'a and Witr, Nafilat al-Sabah...even if only one prayer was offered

-reciting Duaa (supplications); we can refer to the Duaas narrated by the prophet (sawas), his holy progeny (a.s.), Quranic Duaas, or through your own words; speaking to Allah in your own words, sharing your concerns with Him, praying for your needs and of those around you...

-attempting to recite the longer Duaas (especially Duaa Abu Hamza Thumali) at least once during this month, even if it were divided across a couple of days, and focusing on shorter Duaas which only take a couple of minutes

-performing acts on behalf of our deceased loved ones

-reciting the following Duaas after every obligatory prayer, which is a gateway for the forgiveness of one's sins till the Day of Judgement:

allahumma ashbi` kulla ja'i`in O Allah, (please do) satisfy all hungry ones.

ٱللَّهُمَّ ٱكُسُكُلَّ عُرْيَانٍ

allahumma iksu kulla`uryan O Allah, (please do) provide all the naked with clothes.

ٱللَّهُمَّ ٱتَْضِدَيْنَ كُلِّمَدِينٍ

allahumma iqdi dayna kulli madinin O Allah, (please do) help all the debtors settle their debts.

ٱللَّهُرَّ فَرِّجْ عَنُ كُلِّ مَكُرُوبٍ

allahumma farrij`an kulli makrub O Allah, (please do) relieve all the aggrieved ones.

ٱللَّهُمَّ مُدَّكُلٌ غَرِيبٍ

allahumma rudda kulla gharib O Allah, (please do) help all the strangers to return home.

ٱللَّهُوَّ فُكَّ كُلَّ أَسِيرِ

allahumma fukka kulla asir O Allah, (please do) release all prisoners.

ٱللَّهُرَّ أَصْلِحُ كُلَّ فَاسِرٍ مِنْ أُمُورِ ٱلْمُسْلِمِين

allahumma aslih kulla fasidin min umuri almuslimina O Allah, (please do) rectify all the Muslims' affairs that are wrong.

ٱللَّهُوَّ ٱشْفِ كُلَّ مَرِيضٍ

allahumma ishfi kulla marid O Allah, (please do) heal all the ailed ones.

ٱللَّهُرَّسُ **فَق**ُرَنَا بِغِنَاكَ

allahumma sudda faqrana bighinak O Allah, (please do) fill our poverty with Your richness.

ٱللَّهُمَّ غَيِّر سُوءَ حَالِتَا بِحُسُنِ حَالِكَ

allahumma ghayyir su'a halina bihusni halik O Allah, (please do) change our ill manners through Your excellent manners.

ٱللَّهُمَّ ٱتَّضِعَنَّا ٱلدَّيْنَ وَأَغْنِنَا مِنَ ٱلْفَقُرِ

allahumma iqdi`anna alddayna wa aghnina min alfaqr O Allah, (please do) help us settle our debts and save us from poverty.

anta alrrabbu al`azimu You are the All-great Lord

ٱلَّنِيلَيُسَ كَمِثْلِهِشَيْءٌ

alladhi laysa kamithlihi shay`un like Whom there is nothing,

وهُوَٱلسَّحِيعُٱلْبَصِيرُ

wa huwa alssami`u albasiru and He is the All-hearing, the All-aware.

وَهٰلَا شَهُرٌ عَظَّمْتَهُ وَكَرَّمْتَهُ

wa hadha shahrun `azzamtahu wa karramtahu This is a month that You have glorified, ennobled,

وَشَرَّ فُتَهُ وَفَضَّلْتَهُ عَلَىٰ ٱلشُّهُو بِ

wa sharraftahu wa faddaltahu `ala alshshuhuri honored, and preferred to the other months.

وهُوَ ٱلشَّهُرُ ٱلَّانِي فَرَضْتَ صِيَامَةُ عَلَيَّ

wa huwa alshsharhu alladhi faradta siyamahu `alayya It is the month that You imposed upon me to observe fasting in it.

وَهُوَشَهُرُ مَحَمَانَ ٱلَّإِنِي أَنُزَلْتَ فِيهِ الْقُرُ آنَ

wa huwa shahru ramadana alladhi anzalta fihi alqur`ana It is the month of Ramadan during which You revealed the Qur'an

وَجَعَلْتَهَا خَيْرِ أَمِنَ الْفِشَهُرِ

wa ja`altaha khayran min alfi shahrin and You have decided it to be more favorable that one thousand months.

فَيَاذَا ٱلْمَنِّ وَلاَ يُمَنُّ عَلَيْكَ

faya dhalmanni wa la yumannu `alayka So, O Lord of graces! None can ever do favor to You!

مُنَّ عَلَيَّ بِفَكَاكِ ، تَبَنِي مِنَ ٱلتَّارِ فِي مَنُ تَمُنَّ عَلَيْهِ

munna `alayya bifakaki raqabati min alnnari fi man tamunnu `alayhi please, do me a favor by releasing me from the Fire and by including me with those to whom You do this favor.

وَأَدْخِلْنِي ٱلجُنَّةَ

wa adkhilni aljannata and allow me to enter Paradise,

ؠؚڒڂٛٛمؘؾڬٙؽٲٲٛؖؗؗ؇ۛڂڡؘۯٵڵڗٞٵڃٛڡؚؽ

birahmatika ya arhama alrrahimina on account of Your mercy. O most Merciful of all those who show mercy! -refraining from harming others; friends, family, neighbors, colleagues...which may seem to be simple or unimportant, yet one would find themselves shocked on the Day of Judgement before the repercussions of such an act

-establishing the bonds of kinship (صلة الأرحام), which is always obligatory upon us and forbidden to abandon, yet the consequence of its abandonment in the month of Ramadan is multiplied

-amending one's nature and manners

-showing mercy and compassion to the orphans

-respecting elders and showing mercy to the younger

-abstaining our senses from forbidden acts; looking at haram, listening to haram...

-paying sadaqa (alms-giving)

-looking after the poor, especially those who are too humble to ask for help

-aiding a pious Muslim who spent their day fasting in breaking their fast, whether by inviting them to one's home, or giving them the resources that would help them break their fast –even if with only half a date; no one should be left unable to break their fast

-The holy prophet, when Imam Ali asked him of the noblest of deeds during this month said, "O Abu'l-Hasan, the noblest of deeds in this month is abstaining from what the Honorable and Exalted God has forbidden..."

We should refrain ourselves from lying, stealing, backbiting...

Even if the devils are chained, we shall look out for our own evil-insinuating selves, the Nafs (اللَفُس الأَمّارة بالسّوء).
