general ability in the present

I can speak three languages.

#### BEASISE TO

general ability in the present or future


I will be able to speak five languages next year.



### COULD

general ability in the past

I could read when I was five.



# WAS/WERE ABIGETO

ability to do something on a specific occasion in the past


I wasn't able to open the door because I lost my key.



#### SHOULD OUGHT TO HAD SETTER

giving advice

You should/ought to/had better study more.





### SHOULD OUGHT TO HAD SETTER

saying what is the right thing to do

You should help your grandparents more.



### NEED TO HAVE TO


expressing necessity

You have to talk to the principal about that.

expressing lack of necessity

I don't need to get up early tomorrow because it's Sunday.






# MUST

obligation


You must attend the training tomorrow.

#### MUSIT



strong recommendation

You must go to that new restaurant, the food is brilliant!



## MUSINI

prohibition

You mustn't smoke.



#### MUSTRITUS. DON'T HAVE TO

You mustn't eat anything before the blood test. (it's not allowed)

You don't have to sit the exam. It's optional.
