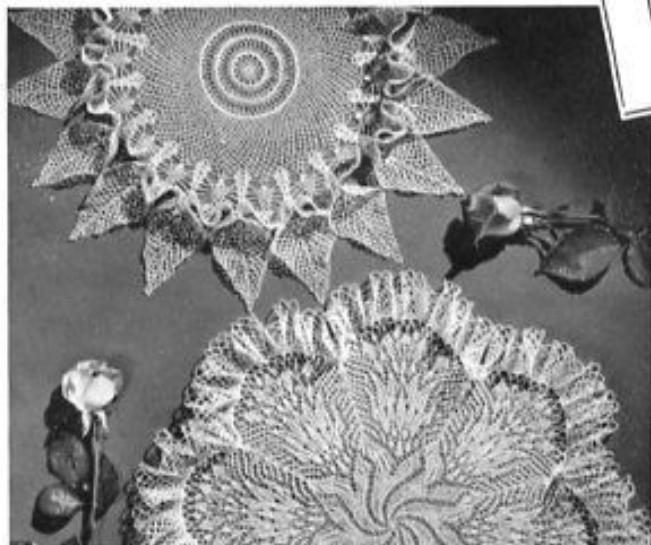

Sunburst . . . S-582

J. & P. COATS BIG BALL BEST SIX CORD MERCERIZED CROCHET, Art. A.104, Size 30; 2 balls of Ecru; or CLARK'S BIG BALL MERCERIZED CROCHET, Art. B.34, Size 30; 2 balls of No. 61 Ecru.

J. & P. COATS "KNIT-CRO-SHEEN," Art. A.64, a few yards of Ecru.

Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 10.

Doily measures 20 inches from point to point.

Starting at center, ch 5. Join with sl st to form ring.
1st rnd: Ch 3, 13 dc in ring. Join to top of ch-3. **2nd rnd:** Sc in same place as sl st. * ch 3, sc in next dc. Repeat from * around, ending with ch 1, half dc in first sc (14 loops). **3rd rnd:** Sc in loop just formed, * ch 4, sc in next loop. Repeat from * around, ending with ch 2, half dc in first sc. **4th rnd:** Sc in loop just formed, * ch 5, sc in next loop. Repeat from * around. Join to first sc. **5th rnd:** Working over 4 strands of "Knit-Cro-Sheen," make 5 sc in each loop around (70 sc). Join. Cut off "Knit-Cro-Sheen." **6th rnd:** Sc in same place as sl st. * ch 3, skip next sc, sc in next sc. Repeat from * around (35 loops). Join. **7th rnd:** Sl st in next loop, ch 7, * tr in next loop, ch 3. Repeat from * around. Join to 4th ch of ch-7. **8th rnd:** Sl st in next sp, sc in same sp. * ch 4, sc in next sp. Repeat from * around. Join. **9th rnd:** Working over 4 strands of "Knit-Cro-Sheen," make * (4 sc in next loop, 5 sc in each of next 3 loops) twice; 4 sc in next loop, 5 sc in each of next 2 loops. Repeat from * around, ending with 5 sc in last loop (165 sc). Join.

10th rnd: Sc in same place as sl st. * ch 3, skip 2 sc, sc in next sc. Repeat from * around (55 loops). Join. **11th and 12th rnds:** Repeat 7th and 8th rnds. **13th rnd:** Working over 4 strands of "Knit-Cro-Sheen," make * 5 sc in each of next 10 loops, 4 sc in next loop. Repeat from * around (270 sc). Join. **14th rnd:** Repeat 10th rnd, ending with ch 1, half dc in first sc (90 loops). **15th to 22nd rnds incl:** Repeat 3rd rnd. **23rd to 26th rnds incl:** Repeat 4th rnd, ending with ch 2, dc in first sc. **27th rnd:** Sc in loop just formed, * (ch 5, sc in next loop) 4 times; ch 6, sc in next loop. Repeat from * around, ending with ch 3, dc in first sc. **28th rnd:** Ch 3, dc in loop just formed, * ch 3, sc in next loop, (ch 5, sc in next loop) 3 times; ch 3, in next loop make 2 dc, ch 3 and 2 dc. Repeat from * around, ending with 2 dc in same place as first dc, ch 1, half dc in top of ch-3. **29th rnd:** Ch 3, dc in sp just formed, * dc in next 2 dc, ch 5, skip next sp, (sc in next loop, ch 5) 3 times; dc in next 2 dc, in next sp make 2 dc, ch 3 and 2 dc. Repeat from * around. Join as before. **30th rnd:** Ch 3, dc in sp just formed, * dc in next 4 dc, ch 5, skip next sp, sc in next loop, ch 6, sc in next loop, ch 5, dc in next 4 dc, in next sp make 2 dc, ch 3 and 2 dc. Repeat from * around. Join. **31st rnd:** Ch 3, dc in sp just formed, * dc in next 3 dc, ch 6, skip next sp, in next loop make (tr, ch 1) 4 times and tr; ch 6, skip 3 dc, dc in next 3 dc, in next sp make 2 dc, ch 3 and 2 dc. Repeat from * around. Join.

32nd rnd: Ch 3, dc in sp just formed, * dc in next 2 dc, ch 6, (sc in next sp, ch 3) 5 times; sc in next sp, ch 6, skip 3 dc, dc in next 2 dc, in next sp make 2 dc.

Whirlpool . . . S-583

J. & P. COATS BIG BALL BEST SIX CORD MERCERIZED CROCHET, Art. A.104, Size 30: 3 balls of White; or CLARK'S BIG BALL MERCERIZED CROCHET, Art. B.34, Size 30: 3 balls of White.

5 Double-pointed Steel Needles No. 1 (2½ mm. size).

Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 9.

Doily measures 16 inches in diameter (excluding ruffle).

Starting at center with double-pointed needles, cast on 8 sts. Divide sts among 3 needles. Join and knit into back of sts, being careful not to twist sts. Insert a marker to indicate the beginning of rnd. Always slip marker from one needle to another at beginning of each rnd.

Now work in pattern as follows: **1st rnd:** * O, k 1. Repeat from * around (8 sts increased—16 sts). **2nd and all even rnds:** K around. **3rd rnd:** * O, k 2. Repeat from * around (24 sts). **5th rnd:** * O, k 1, make a cross st over next 2 sts—to make a cross st, slip next st, knit the 2nd st on left hand needle, then knit the skipped st, slip both sts off needle. Repeat from * around (32 sts). **7th rnd:** * O, k 1, cross st, k 1. Repeat from * around (40 sts). **9th rnd:** * O, k 1, cross st, k 2 tog. Repeat from * around (40 sts). **11th rnd:** * O, k 1, cross st, k 2. Repeat from * around (48 sts). **13th rnd:** * O, k 1, cross st, k 1, k 2 tog. Repeat from * around (48 sts). **15th rnd:** * O, k 1, cross st, k 3. Repeat from * around (56 sts). **17th rnd:** * O, k 1, make 2 cross sts, k 2 tog. Repeat from * around (56 sts). **19th rnd:** * O, k 1, make 2 cross sts, k 2. Repeat from * around (64 sts). **21st rnd:** * O, k 1, make 2 cross sts, k 1, k 2 tog. Repeat from * around (64 sts). **23rd rnd:** * O, k 1, make 3 cross sts, k 1. Repeat from * around (72 sts). **25th rnd:** * O, k 1, make 3 cross sts, k 2 tog. Repeat from * around (72 sts). **27th rnd:** * O, k 1, make 3 cross sts, k 2. Repeat from * around (80 sts). **29th rnd:** * O, k 1, cross st, k 2. Repeat from * around (96 sts).

31st rnd: * O, k 1, make 2 cross sts, k 1. Repeat from * around (112 sts). **33rd rnd:** * O, k 1, make 2 cross sts, k 2 tog. Repeat from * around (112 sts). **35th rnd:** * O, k 1, cross st, (k 2 tog) twice; (O, k 1) twice; make 2 cross sts, k 1. Repeat from * around (120 sts). **37th rnd:** * O, k 2, cross st, k 2 tog, O, k 3, O, k 1, make 2 cross sts, k 1. Repeat from * around (136 sts). **39th rnd:** Slip first st of left-hand needle onto the right-hand needle, * sl 1, k 1, p.s.s.o., k 1, k 2 tog, O, k 1, O, k 3, (O, k 1) twice; make 2 cross sts, k 2, O. Repeat from * to last 16 sts, sl 1, k 1, p.s.s.o., k 1, k 2 tog, O, k 1, O, k 3, (O, k 1) twice; make 2 cross sts, k 1, then knit the slipped st, O (160 sts). **41st rnd:** * Sl 1, k 1, p.s.s.o., k 1, (O, k 3) 3 times; O, k 1, make 3 cross sts, k 1, O. Repeat from * around (192 sts). **43rd rnd:** * Sl 1, k 1, p.s.s.o., (O, k 1, O, sl 1, k 2 tog, p.s.s.o.) 3 times; O, k 1, O, (sl 1, k 1, p.s.s.o.) twice; make 2 cross sts, k 1, O. Repeat from *

around (192 sts). **45th rnd:** * K 1, O, sl 1, k 2 tog, p.s.s.o., O, (knit into back of next st, O, k 3, O) twice; knit into back of next st, O, sl 1, k 2 tog, p.s.s.o., O, (sl 1, k 1, p.s.s.o.) twice; make 2 cross sts, O. Repeat from * around (216 sts). **46th rnd:** * K 4, (knit into back of next st, k 5) twice; knit into back of next st, k 10. Repeat from * around (216 sts). **47th rnd:** Slip first st of left-hand needle onto the right-hand needle, * (O, k 1) twice; (O, k 3, O, sl 1, k 2 tog, p.s.s.o.) twice; O, k 3, O, (k 1, O) twice; (sl 1, k 1, p.s.s.o.) twice; make 2 cross sts. Repeat from * to last 26 sts, (O, k 1) twice; (O, k 3, O, sl 1, k 2 tog, p.s.s.o.) twice; O, k 3, O, (k 1, O) twice; (sl 1, k 1, p.s.s.o.) twice; cross st, k 1, then knit the slipped st (248 sts). **48th and all even rnds:** K around. **49th rnd:** * O, sl 1, k 2 tog, p.s.s.o., (O, k 1, O, k 5) 3 times; O, k 1, O, sl 1, k 2 tog, p.s.s.o., O, sl 1, k 1, p.s.s.o., k 1, cross st, k 1. Repeat from * around (288 sts).

51st rnd: * O, k 2 tog, O, sl 1, k 2 tog, p.s.s.o., O, make 5 cross sts, knit and purl into the next st, make 5 cross sts, O, sl 1, k 2 tog, p.s.s.o., O, sl 1, k 1, p.s.s.o., O, sl 1, k 1, p.s.s.o., k 1, k 2 tog. Repeat from * around (280 sts). **53rd rnd:** * (O, k 2 tog) twice; O, k 1, make 11 cross sts, k 1, O, (sl 1, k 1, p.s.s.o., O) twice; sl 1, k 2 tog, p.s.s.o. Repeat from * around (280 sts). **55th rnd:** Slip 2 sts from left-hand needle to right-hand needle, * O, k 2 tog, O, (make 3 cross sts, O, make 2 cross sts, O) twice; make 3 cross sts, (O, sl 1, k 1, p.s.s.o.) twice; k 1, k 2 tog. Repeat from * to last 33 sts, O, k 2 tog, O, (make 3 cross sts, O, make 2 cross sts, O) twice; make 3 cross sts, (O, sl 1, k 1, p.s.s.o.) twice; k 1, then knit the 2 slipped sts together (312 sts). **56th rnd:** * K 9, p and k into next st, k 4, p and k into next st, k 6, p and k into next st, k 4, p and k into next st, k 12. Repeat from * around (344 sts). **57th rnd:** * O, sl 1, k 2 tog, p.s.s.o., O, sl 1, k 1, p.s.s.o., make 6 cross sts, sl 1, k 1, p.s.s.o., cross st, k 2 tog, make 6 cross sts, k 2 tog, (O, sl 1, k 2 tog, p.s.s.o.) twice. Repeat from * around (296 sts). **58th and all even rnds:** K around. **59th rnd:** Slip 2 sts from left-hand needle onto right-hand needle, * O, k 1, O, sl 1, k 1, p.s.s.o., k 1, O, make 5 cross sts, O, sl 1, k 1, p.s.s.o., k 2 tog, O, make 5 cross sts, O, k 1, k 2 tog, O, k 1, O, sl 1, k 1, p.s.s.o., k 1, k 2 tog. Repeat from * to last 35 sts, O, k 1, O, sl 1, k 1, p.s.s.o., k 1, O, make 5 cross sts, O, sl 1, k 1, p.s.s.o., k 2 tog, O, make 5 cross sts, O, k 1, k 2 tog, O, k 1, O, sl 1, k 1, p.s.s.o., k 1, then knit the 2 slipped sts together (312 sts).

61st rnd: * O, k 2 tog, O, k 1, O, sl 1, k 1, p.s.s.o., k 1, O, make 5 cross sts, k 1, O, k 2 tog, O, k 1, make 5 cross sts, O, k 1, k 2 tog, O, k 1, O, sl 1, k 1, p.s.s.o., O, sl 1, k 2 tog, p.s.s.o. Repeat from * around (336 sts). **63rd rnd:** * K 2 tog, O, sl 1, k 2 tog, p.s.s.o., O, sl 1, k 1, p.s.s.o., k 1, O, sl 1, k 1, p.s.s.o., make 5 cross sts, k 1, make 5 cross sts, k 2 tog, O, k 1, k 2 tog, O, sl 1, k 2 tog, p.s.s.o., O, sl 1, k 1, p.s.s.o., k 1. Repeat from * around (304 sts). **65th rnd:** Sl 1, * k 2 tog, O, k 1, O, sl 1, k 1, p.s.s.o., k 1, O, (sl 1, k 1, p.s.s.o., k 1, k 2 tog,

J. & P. COATS BIG BALL BEST SIX CORD MERCERIZED CROCHET, Art. A.104, Size 30; 6 balls of White; or

CLARK'S BIG BALL MERCERIZED CROCHET, Art. B.34, Size 30; 4 balls of White.

Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 10.

Centerpiece measures 22 inches in diameter, including ruffle.

FIRST MOTIF . . . Starting at center, ch 8. Join with sl st to form ring. **1st rnd:** 18 sc in ring. Join. **2nd rnd:** Ch 12, * skip 2 sc, dc in next sc, ch 9. Repeat from * around. Join to 3rd ch of ch-12. **3rd rnd:** * 9 sc in next loop, ch 5. Repeat from * around, ending with ch 2, dc in first sc. **4th rnd:** * Ch 5, skip 1 sc, sc in next 7 sc, ch 5, sc in next loop. Repeat from * around, ending with ch 2, dc in dc. **5th rnd:** Ch 5, sc in next loop, * ch 5, skip 1 sc, sc in next 5 sc, (ch 5, sc in next loop) twice. Repeat from * around, ending with ch 2, dc in dc. **6th rnd:** (Ch 5, sc in next loop) twice; * ch 5, skip 1 sc, sc in next 3 sc, (ch 5, sc in next loop) 3 times. Repeat from * around. Join as before. **7th rnd:** (Ch 5, sc in next loop) 3 times; * ch 5, skip 1 sc, sc in next sc, (ch 5, sc in next loop) 4 times. Repeat from * around. Join. **8th rnd:** * Ch 5, sc in next loop. Repeat from * around, ending with ch 5, sl st in dc. Break off.

SECOND MOTIF . . . Work as for First Motif until 7 rnds have been completed. **8th rnd:** (Ch 5, sc in next loop) twice; (ch 2, sl st in corresponding loop on First Motif, ch 2, sc in next loop on Second Motif) 5 times. Complete rnd (no more joinings).

Make 17 more motifs, joining adjacent sides as Second Motif was joined to First Motif, following diagram.



Diagram for Joining Motifs

Now work in rnds as follows: **1st rnd:** Attach thread to 2nd free loop of any corner motif, sc in same place, * (ch 5, sc in next loop) 14 times; ch 3, holding back on hook the last loop of each dc, make dc in next 2 joined loops, thread over and draw through all loops on hook (joint dc made); ch 3, sc in next loop, (ch 5, sc in next loop) 9 times; ch 3, make a joint dc over next 2 joined loops, ch 3, sc in next loop. Repeat from * around. Join to first sc. **2nd rnd:** Sl st to center of next loop, ch 9, (tr in next loop, ch 5) 12 times; * tr in next loop, ch 3, make a joint tr by making a tr in next 2 ch-3 sps, ch 3, (tr in next loop, ch 5) 8

Wedding Ring . . . S-585

J. & P. COATS BIG BALL BEST SIX CORD MERCERIZED CROCHET, Art. A.104, Size 30; 1 ball each of White and No. 8 Blue; or

CLARK'S BIG BALL MERCERIZED CROCHET, Art. B.34, Size 30; 1 ball each of White and No. 8 Blue.

Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 10.

A hairpin lace staple, 5/8 inch wide.

Doily measures 13 inches in diameter.

Starting at center with White, ch 5. Join with sl st to form ring. **1st rnd:** Ch 3, 23 dc in ring. Join to top of ch-3. Break off. **2nd rnd:** Attach Blue to same place as sl st, sc in same place, * ch 3, sc in next dc. Repeat from * around. Join (24 loops). **3rd to 6th rnds incl:** Sl st in next loop, sc in same loop, * ch 3, sc in next loop. Repeat from * around. Join. Break off at end of 6th rnd—First Blue Stripe completed.

FIRST HAIRPIN LACE STRIP . . . With White, make a strip of hairpin lace, having 72 loops on each side of staple. Break off.

To Join Hairpin Lace to Center: Always keeping the twist in all loops, attach White through first 3 loops, sc in same place, ch 2, sl st in any loop on Center, * ch 2, sc through next 3 loops on hairpin lace, ch 2,

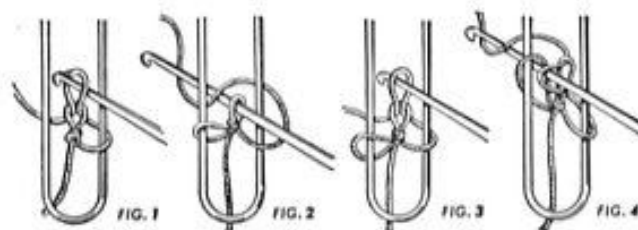
sl st in next loop on Center. Repeat from * around. Join and break off. Sew center of hairpin lace together.

SECOND BLUE STRIPE . . . Attach Blue to first loop on opposite side of hairpin lace, sc in same place, * ch 3, sc in next loop. Repeat from * around. Join (72 loops). **2nd to 7th rnds incl:** Sl st in next loop, sc in same loop, * ch 3, sc in next loop. Repeat from * around. Join. Break off at end of 7th rnd.

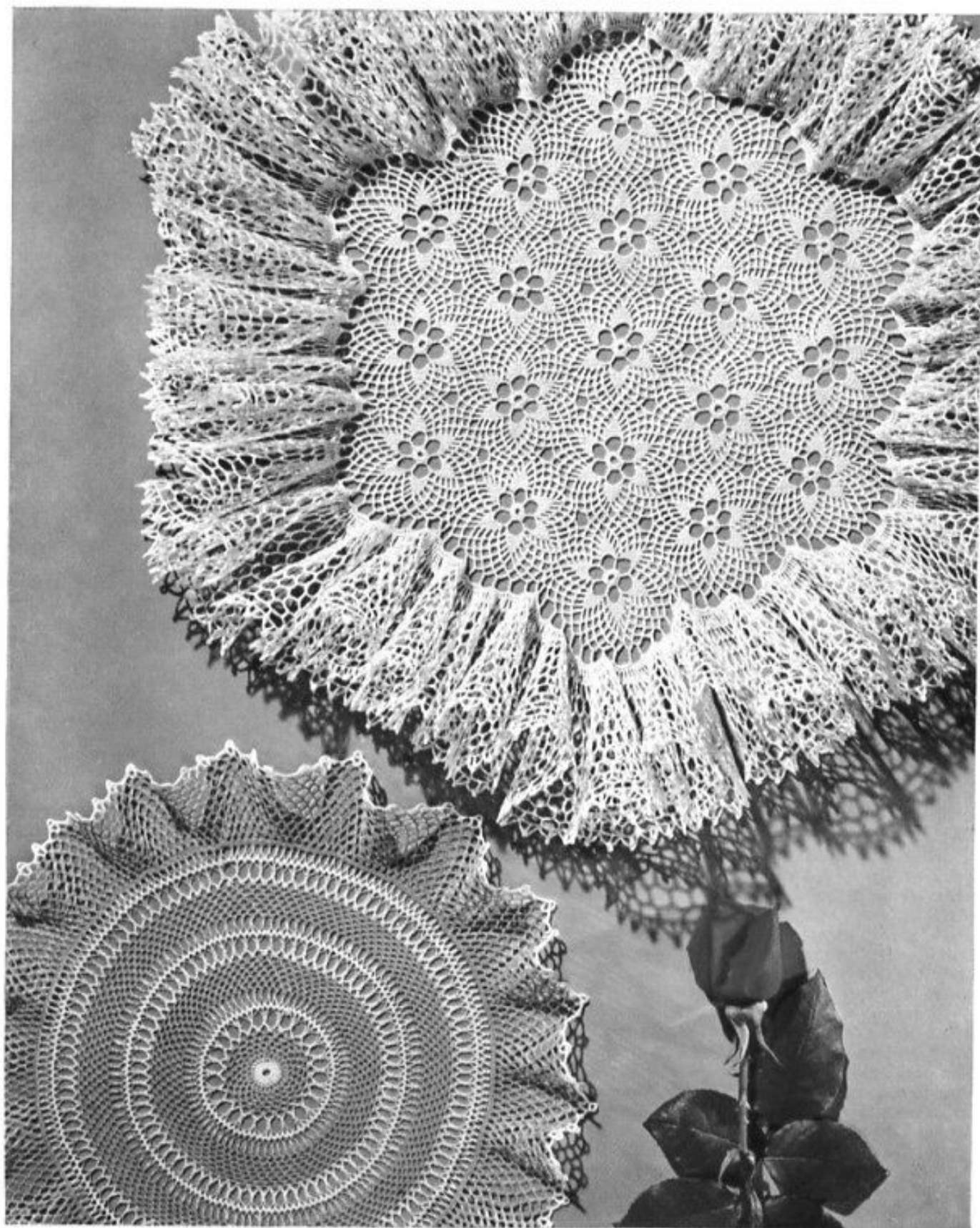
SECOND HAIRPIN LACE STRIP . . . With White make a strip of hairpin lace, having 144 loops on each side of staple. Break off. Join to Center as before, making sc through 2 loops on hairpin lace instead of 3.

THIRD BLUE STRIPE . . . 1st rnd: Attach Blue to first loop on opposite side of hairpin lace, sc in same place, (ch 3, sc in next loop) twice; ch 3, sc through next 2 loops, thus working off 2 loops as 1 st. Continue to

J. & P. COATS BIG BALL BEST SIX CORD MERCERIZED CROCHET, Art. A.104, Size 30; 2 balls of Ecrú, or

CLARK'S BIG BALL MERCERIZED CROCHET, Art. B.34, Size 30; 2 balls of No. 61 Ecrú.

Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 10.

Doily measures 18 inches in diameter, including ruffle.

Starting at center, ch 8. Join with sl st to form ring.
1st rnd: Ch 3, 23 dc in ring. Join. **2nd rnd:** Sc in same place as sl st, * ch 3, skip 1 dc, sc in next dc. Repeat from * around. Join. **3rd rnd:** Sl st in next loop, ch 4, holding back on hook the last loop of each tr make 2 tr in same place, thread over and draw through all loops on hook (cluster made); * ch 5, make a 3-tr cluster in next loop. Repeat from * around. Join. **4th rnd:** Ch 4, complete a cluster in same place as sl st, ch 5, cluster in same place, * in tip of next cluster make cluster, ch 5 and cluster. Repeat from * around. Join. **5th rnd:** Ch 4 and complete a cluster in same place as sl st, * ch 5, cluster in next cluster, ch 3, cluster in next cluster. Repeat from * around. Join. **6th rnd:** Ch 4, holding back on hook the last loop of each tr make 2 tr in same place as sl st and 3 tr in tip of next cluster, thread over and draw through all loops on hook (joint-tr cluster made); * ch 5, 5 tr in next sp, ch 5, make a joint cluster over next 2 clusters. Repeat from * around. Join. **7th rnd:** Sl st to center of next sp, ch 4, 2 tr in same sp, * tr in next 3 tr, ch 3, tr in same place as last tr, tr in next 2 tr, 3 tr in next sp, ch 3, 3 tr in next sp. Repeat from * around. Join.

8th rnd: Ch 4, tr in next 5 tr, * in next sp make tr, ch 3 and tr; tr in next 6 tr, ch 3, tr in next 6 tr. Repeat from * around. Join. **9th and 10th rnds:** Ch 4, * tr in each tr across group, in sp make tr, ch 3 and tr; tr in each tr across next group, ch 3. Repeat from * around. Join. **11th rnd:** Sl st in next 2 tr, ch 4, * tr in each tr across group, in sp make tr, ch 3 and tr; tr in next 7 tr, ch 5, sc in next sp, ch 5, skip 2 tr. Repeat from * around. Join. **12th rnd:** Sl st in next 2 tr, ch 4, * tr in each tr across group, in sp make tr, ch 3 and tr; tr in next 6 tr, (ch 5, sc in next loop) twice; ch 5,

skip 2 tr. Repeat from * around. Join. **13th rnd:** Sl st in next 2 tr, ch 4, tr in next 4 tr, * in next sp make tr, ch 3 and tr; tr in next 5 tr, (ch 5, sc in next loop) 3 times; ch 5, skip 2 tr, tr in next 5 tr. Repeat from * around. Join. **14th rnd:** Sl st in next 2 tr, ch 4, tr in next 3 tr, * in next sp make tr, ch 3 and tr; tr in next 4 tr, ch 7, skip next loop, sc in next loop, ch 5, sc in next loop, ch 7, skip 2 tr, tr in next 4 tr. Repeat from * around. Join. **15th rnd:** Sl st in next 2 tr, ch 4, tr in next 2 tr, * in next sp make tr, ch 3 and tr; tr in next 3 tr, ch 7, holding back on hook the last loop of each tr make tr in next 2 loops, thread over and draw through all loops on hook (joint tr made); ch 3, tr in same loop, ch 3, make another joint tr by making tr in same loop and in next loop, ch 7, skip 2 tr, tr in next 3 tr. Repeat from * around. Join.

16th rnd: Sl st in next 2 tr, ch 4, tr in next tr, * in next sp make tr, ch 3 and tr; tr in next 2 tr, ch 7, 3 sc in next sp, (in next sp make 2 sc, ch 3 and 2 sc) twice; 3 sc in next sp, ch 7, skip 2 tr, tr in next 2 tr. Repeat from * around. Join. **17th rnd:** Sl st in next 2 tr, ch 4, * in next sp make tr, ch 3 and tr; tr in next tr, ch 7, 3 sc in next sp, (ch 5, sc in next ch-3 loop) twice; ch 5, 3 sc in next loop, ch 7, skip 2 tr, tr in next tr. Repeat from * around. Join. **18th rnd:** Sl st in next tr, sc in same place, * in next sp make 2 sc, ch 3 and 2 sc; sc in next tr, ch 6, dc in next loop, (in next loop make tr, ch 5 and tr) 3 times; dc in next loop, ch 6, skip next tr, sc in next tr. Repeat from * around. Join. **19th rnd:** Sl st in next 2 sc and in next ch-3 loop, sc in same loop, * ch 7, sc in next loop. Repeat from * around. Join. **20th rnd:** Sl st to center of next loop, sc in same loop, * ch 8, sc in next loop. Repeat from * around. Join. **21st and 22nd rnds:** Work as for 20th rnd, making ch-9 loops on 21st rnd and ch-10 loops on 22nd rnd.

RUFFLE . . . 1st rnd: Sl st to center of next loop, sc in same place, * ch 8, sc in next loop. Repeat from * around. Join. **2nd rnd:** 8 sc in each loop around. Join. **3rd rnd:** Sc in same place as sl st, * ch 5, skip 1 sc, sc in next sc. Repeat from * around, ending with ch 2, dc in first sc. **4th to 17th rnds incl:** * Ch 5, sc in next loop. Repeat from * around, ending with ch 2, dc in dc. At end of 17th rnd, ch 5, sl st in dc. Break off. Starch lightly and press.

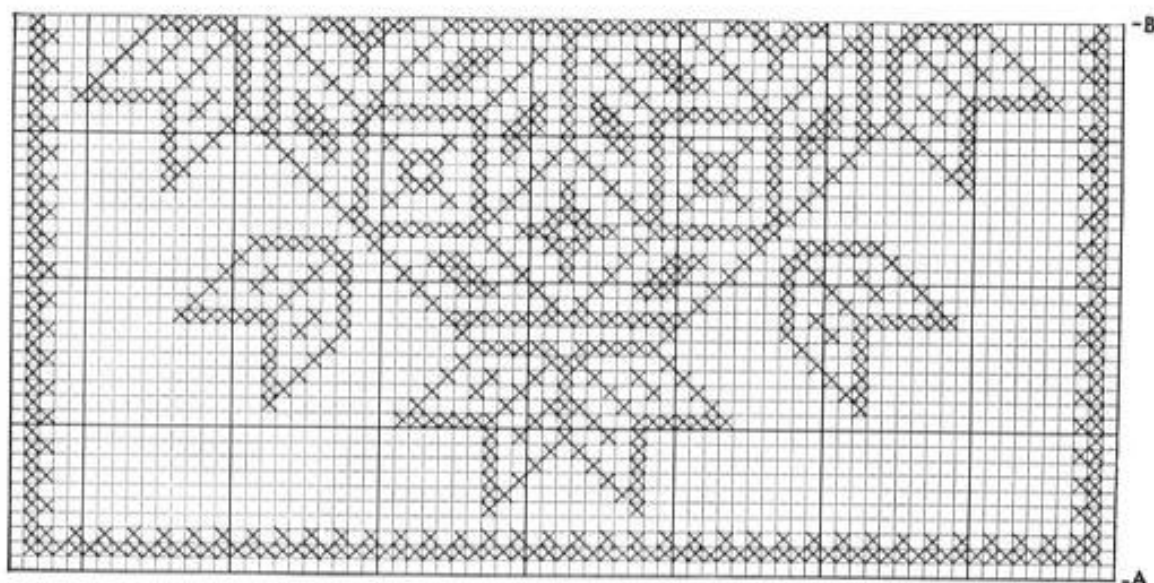
GAUGE: 6 sps make 1 inch; 6 rows make 1 inch.

Doily measures 16 inches square, including ruffle.

Starting at "A" on chart, ch 230 to measure 13 inches. **1st row:** Dc in 8th ch from hook (sp made), * ch 2, skip 2 ch, dc in next ch (another sp made). Repeat from * across (75 sps). Ch 5, turn. **2nd row:** Skip first dc, dc in next dc (sp made over sp), * 2 dc

in next sp, dc in next dc (bl made over sp). Repeat from * across to within last sp, ch 2, skip 2 ch, dc in next ch. Ch 5, turn. **3rd row:** Skip first dc, dc in next dc, dc in next 6 dc (2 bls made over 2 bls), * ch 2, skip 2 dc, dc in next dc (sp made over bl), dc in next 3 dc (bl made over bl). Repeat from * across, ending with 2 bls, 1 sp. Ch 5, turn. Starting with 4th row, follow chart to "B," then reverse chart and, omitting last row, follow chart back to "A." Break off.

RUFFLE . . . 1st rnd: Attach thread to sp following any corner sp, 3 sc in each sp around, making 7 sc in each corner. Join. **2nd rnd:** Sc in same place as sl st, * ch 5, skip 1 sc, sc in next sc. Repeat from * across to center sc at corner, ending with ch 5, in center sc make (sc, ch 5) 3 times; skip 1 sc, sc in next sc and complete other sides and corners the same way, ending with ch 2, dc in first sc. **3rd, 4th and 5th rnds:** * Ch 6, sc in next loop. Repeat from * around, ending with ch 3, dc in dc. **6th rnd:** * Ch 7, sc in next loop. Repeat from * around, ending with ch 3, tr in dc. **7th to 10th rnds incl:** Work as for last rnd, ending with ch 3, tr in tr. Break off at end of 10th rnd. Starch lightly and press.



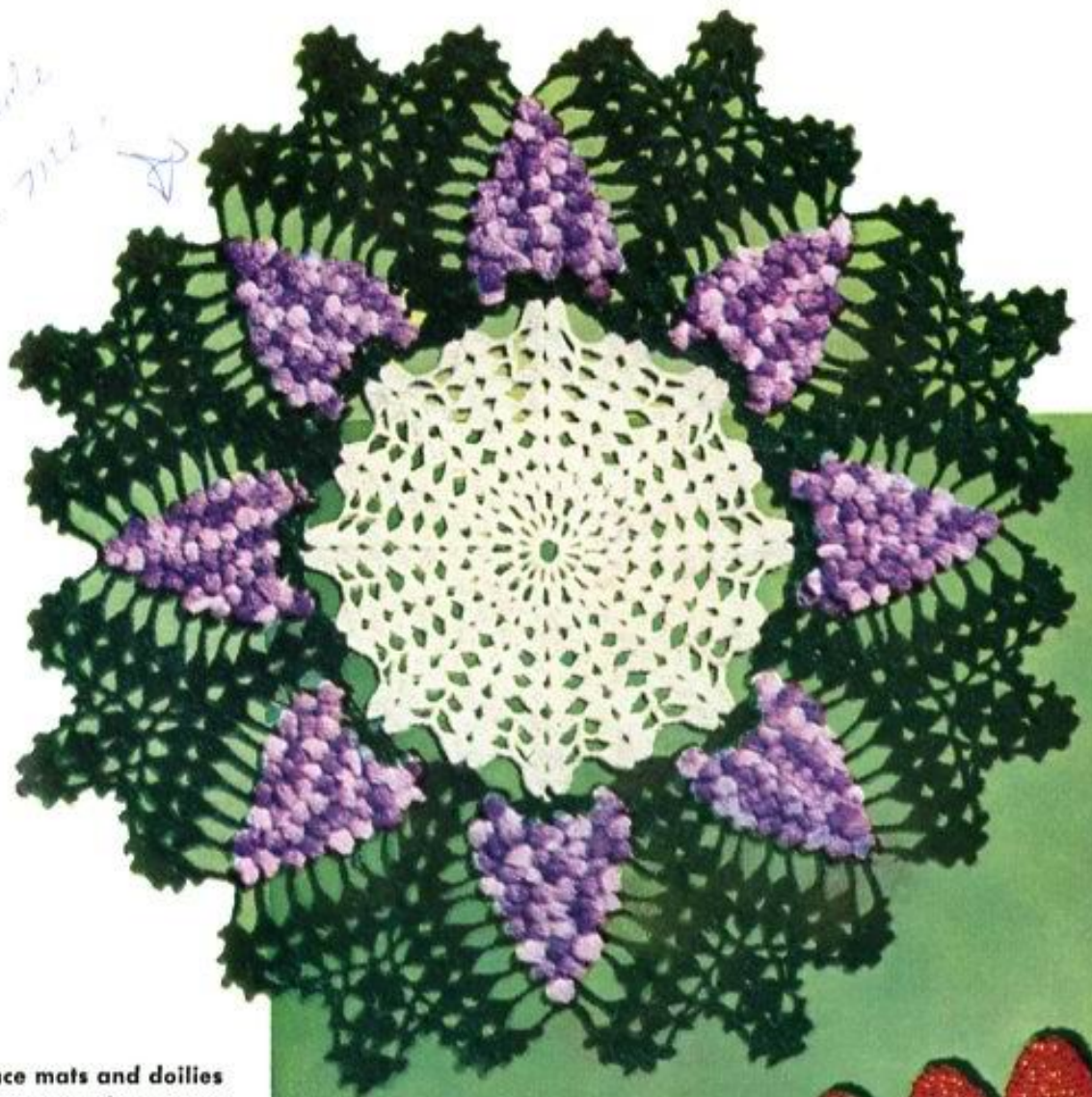

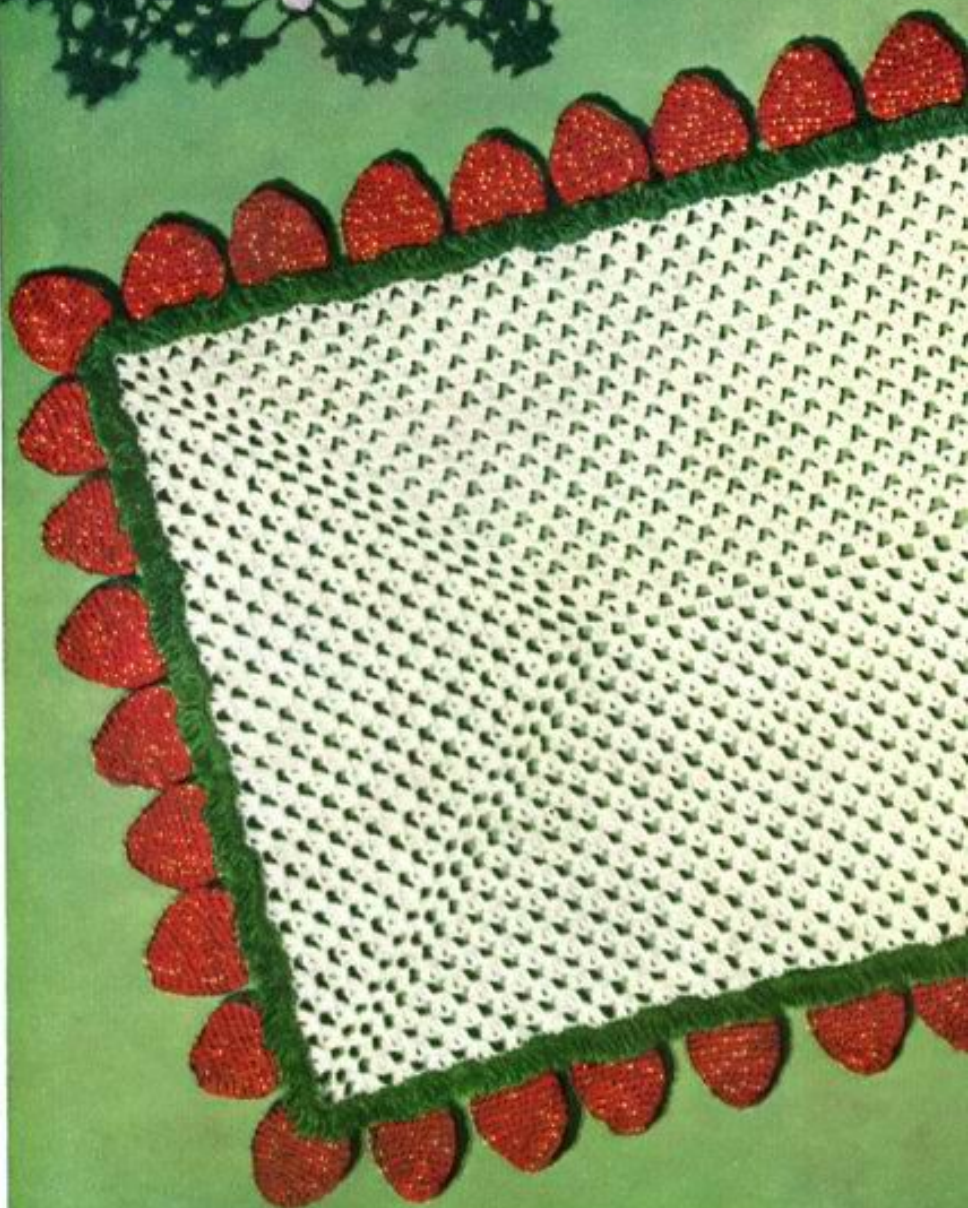
from hook—picot made) 3 times and 2 dc. Repeat from * around, ending with picot loop. Join with sl st.

Repeat from * around, making (dc, ch 5) 4 times in center loop on each point. Join as before. **46th rnd:** * Sc in next loop, ch 5. Repeat from * to center loop of next point, in center loop make dc, 3 picots and dc. Continue in pattern, completing all points the same way. Join and break off. Starch lightly and press.

Doily measures 17½ inches in diameter.

Starting at center with White, ch 10. Join with sl st to form ring. **1st rnd:** Ch 5, (dc in ring, ch 2) 15 times; join to 3rd ch of ch-5 (16 sps). **2nd rnd:** Sl st in next sp, ch 3, dc in same sp, * ch 2, 2 dc in next sp. Repeat from * around. Join last ch-2 to top of ch-3. **3rd rnd:** Sl st in next sp, ch 3, in same sp make dc, ch 3 and 2 dc; * in next sp make 2 dc, ch 3 and 2 dc (shell made). Repeat from * around. Join. **4th and 5th rnds:** Sl st to sp of next shell, ch 3, in same shell make 2 dc, ch 3 and 3 dc; * in sp of next shell make 3 dc, ch 3 and 3 dc. Repeat from * around. Join. **6th and 7th rnds:** Sl st to sp of next shell, ch 3, in same shell make 3 dc, ch 3 and 4 dc; * in next sp make 4 dc, ch 3 and 4 dc. Repeat from * around. Join. **8th rnd:** Sl st to sp of next shell, ch 3, in same shell make 3 dc, ch 3 and 4 dc; * ch 2, dc in first dc of next shell, ch 2, in sp of next shell make 4 dc, ch 3 and 4 dc. Repeat from * around. Join. **9th rnd:** Sl st to sp of next shell, ch 3, in same sp make 4 dc, ch 3 and 5 dc; * ch 2, skip next sp, dc in next dc, ch 2, in sp of next shell make 5 dc, ch 3 and 5 dc. Repeat from * around. Join and break off. **10th rnd:** Attach Killarney to sp of any shell, ch 4, in same sp make 4 tr, ch 3 and 5 tr; * ch 5, in sp of next shell make (tr, ch 2) 9 times and tr (9 sps); ch 5, in sp of next shell make 5 dc, ch 3 and 5 dc. Repeat from * around. Join and break off.

GRAPES . . . 1st row: Attach Shaded Purples to first sp of any 9-sp group, ch 3, in same sp make 9 dc, drop loop from hook, insert hook in top of first st of this group, draw dropped loop through (pc st made); * ch 2, make 10 dc in next sp, insert hook in first dc of group and complete pc st. Repeat from * across remaining 7 sps. Ch 3, turn. **2nd row:** 9 dc in first ch-2 sp, drop loop from hook, insert hook in top of ch-3 from back to front, draw dropped loop through (inverted pc st); * ch 2, 10 dc in next sp, complete an inverted pc st. Repeat from * across each remaining sp. Ch 3, turn (8 pc sts). Continue working rows of pc sts, having 1 less pc st on each row, until 1 pc st remains. Break off. Make a bunch of grapes the same way over each group of sps.

LEAVES . . . 1st row: Attach Killarney to tip of last pc st made on first row of any set of grapes, ch 5, in sp of shell make 4 tr, ch 3 and 4 tr (shell made); ch 5, sl st in tip of first pc st on first row of next set of grapes, ch 3, sl st in tip of pc st on next row. Ch 5, turn. **2nd and 3rd rows:** Make shell in sp of shell, ch 5, sl st in tip of pc st on next row of grapes, ch 3, sl st in tip of pc st on following row. Ch 5, turn. **4th**

Ch 5, turn. **7th row:** Shell in sp of next shell, ch 3, sc in next sp, ch 3, shell in next loop, ch 3, sc in next sp, ch 3, shell in sp of next shell, ch 5, sl st in tip of next pc st, ch 3, sl st in tip of pc st on next row. Ch 5, turn. **8th row:** Shell in sp of next shell, (ch 3, sc in next sp) twice; ch 3, shell in sp of next shell, (ch 3, sc in next sp) twice; ch 3, shell in sp of next shell, ch 5, sl st in tip of next pc st, ch 3, sl st in tip of pc st on next row. Ch 5, turn. **9th row:** * Tr in sp of next shell, ch 3, sl st in tr just made (picot made), in same sp make (2 tr, picot) 4 times; (ch 3, sc in next sp, picot) 3 times; ch 3. Repeat from * once more; in next sp make tr, picot, (2 tr, picot) 4 times; ch 5, sl st in tip of top pc st. Break off. Work other leaves the same way.

Starch lightly and press.

J. & P. COATS "KNIT-CRO-SHEEN," Art. A.64: 2 balls of No. 1 White and 1 ball of No. 48 Hunter's Green; and

J. & P. COATS "KNIT-CRO-SHEEN" METALLIC, Art. A.64: 4 balls of No. M.126 Spanish Red.

Milwards Steel Crochet Hooks No. 6 and No. 7.

Mat measures 15 x 21 inches.

Starting at center with White, ch 63 to measure 6½ inches. **1st row:** Dc in 8th ch from hook, dc in next 2 ch, (ch 2, skip 2 ch, dc in next 3 ch) 10 times; ch 2, skip 2 ch, dc in next ch. Do not turn.

Now work in rnds as follows: **1st rnd:** Ch 3, dc around bar of last dc made, ch 2, in same sp make 2 dc, ch 5 and 2 dc (corner shell made); (ch 2, in next sp make 2 dc, ch 2 and 2 dc—shell made) 10 times; ch 2, in next sp make (2 dc, ch 5, 2 dc, ch 2) twice; (shell in next sp, ch 2) 10 times; 2 dc in same place as first dc, ch 2, dc in top of starting chain. **2nd rnd:** Ch 3, dc in sp just formed, * ch 2, shell in next sp, ch 2, corner shell over corner shell, (ch 2, shell in next sp between shells) 11 times; ch 2, corner shell over corner shell. Repeat from * around. Join as before. Continue to work as for No. S-590, having 1 shell more on each side on each rnd, until 20 rnds have been completed. Break off at end of 20th rnd.

EDGING . . . 1st rnd: Attach Hunter's Green to first ch on any corner sp, sc in same place, sc in next ch, 3 sc in next ch, sc in each ch and in each dc around, making 3 sc in center ch at each corner. Join. **2nd rnd:**

Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 7.

Mat measures 15 inches square.

Starting at center with White, ch 8. Join with sl st to form ring. **1st rnd:** Ch 3, 4 dc in ring, (ch 3, 5 dc in ring) 3 times; ch 1, half dc in top of ch-3. **2nd rnd:** Ch 3, dc in loop just formed, * ch 2, skip 2 dc, in next dc make 2 dc, ch 2 and 2 dc (shell made); ch 2, in next sp make 2 dc, ch 5 and 2 dc (corner shell made). Repeat from * around, ending with 2 dc in same place as first dc was made, ch 2, dc in top of ch-3. **3rd rnd:** Ch 3, dc in loop just formed, * ch 2, shell in next sp, ch 2, skip next shell, shell in next sp, ch 2, in next sp make 2 dc, ch 5 and 2 dc. Repeat from * around. Join as before. **4th rnd:** Ch 3, dc in loop just formed, * ch 2, shell in next sp, (ch 2, skip next shell, shell in next sp) twice; ch 2, in next sp make 2 dc, ch 5 and 2 dc. Repeat from * around. Join. Continue to work as for 4th rnd, having 1 shell more on each side on each rnd until 20 rnds in all have been completed. Break off at end of 20th rnd.

LEMON (Make 36) . . . Starting at tip with Canary Yellow, ch 4. **1st row:** 5 dc in 4th ch from hook. Ch 1, turn. Now work in rnds as follows: **1st rnd:** 2 sc in each dc and in top of turning chain. Do not join. **2nd rnd:** 2 sc in first sc, sc in next 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 5 sc. **3rd rnd:** (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 6 sc) twice. **4th to 9th rnds incl:** Sc in each sc around. **10th rnd:** (Dec 1 sc—to dec 1 sc, work off 2 sc as 1 sc—sc in next 6 sc) twice. **11th rnd:** * Work off next 2 sc as 1 sc. Repeat from * around. **12th rnd:** Sl st tightly in each sc around. Break off.

LEAF (Make 36) . . . Starting at center with Hunter's Green, ch 9. **1st rnd:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook, half dc in next ch, dc in next 4 ch, half dc in next ch, in next ch make sc, ch 3 and sc; working along opposite

side of starting chain, make half dc in next ch, dc in next 4 ch, half dc in next ch, sc in next ch, sl st in first sc (base). Break off.

STEM . . . Attach Green to center of Lemon, ch 3, sl st in base of leaf, ch 2, sl st in 3rd ch of ch-3, ch 5, sl st in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across. Break off. Sew Leaves and Lemons around Mat.

J. & P. COATS "KNIT-CRO-SHEEN," Art. A.64: 1 ball each of No. 1 White, No. 126 Spanish Red and No. 48 Hunter's Green.

Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 7.

Doily measures 15½ inches in diameter.

CENTER . . . Starting at center with White, ch 8. Join with sl st to form ring. **1st rnd:** Ch 4, (dc in ring, ch 1) 15 times. Join with sl st to 3rd ch of ch-4. **2nd rnd:** Sl st in next sp, ch 3, dc in same sp. * ch 1, 2 dc in next sp. Repeat from * around, ending with ch 1. Join. **3rd rnd:** Sl st in next dc and in next sp, ch 3, in same sp make dc, ch 2 and 2 dc (shell made); in each sp around make 2 dc, ch 2 and 2 dc. Join (16 shells). **4th rnd:** Sl st to sp of next shell, ch 3, shell in same sp, shell in each sp around. Join. **5th and 6th rnds:** Work as for last rnd, making 3 dc, ch 2 and 3 dc in each shell. **7th rnd:** * Shell over next 2 shells, 3 dc between last shell worked and next shell. Repeat from * around. Join. **8th rnd:** * Shell over next 2 shells, shell in center dc of next 3-dc group (1 shell increased). Repeat from * around. Join (24 shells). **9th rnd:** Shell over first shell, * 3 dc between last shell worked and next shell, shell over next 3 shells. Repeat from * around. Join. **10th rnd:** Shell over each shell around, making a shell in center dc of each 3-dc group. Join (32 shells). **11th and 12th rnds:** * Shell over next shell, ch 1. Repeat from * around. Join. **13th rnd:** * Shell over next shell, ch 2. Repeat from * around. Join. **14th rnd:** Work as for last rnd, making 4 dc, ch 2 and 4 dc in each shell. **15th rnd:** * 4-dc shell over next shell, ch 3. Repeat from * around. Join and break off.

CHERRY (Make 48) . . . Starting with Spanish Red, ch 4. **1st rnd:** 13 dc in 4th ch from hook. Join. **2nd rnd:** 2 sc in same place as sl st, 2 sc in each dc around. Join and break off.

LEAF (Make 32) . . . Starting at center with Hunter's Green, ch 13. **1st rnd:** Sl st in 2nd ch from hook and in next ch (outer point of leaf), sc in next ch, half dc in next ch, dc in next 5 ch, half dc in next ch, sc in next ch, 3 sc in next ch; working along opposite side of starting chain, make sc in next ch, half dc in next ch, dc in next 5 ch, half dc in next ch, sc in next ch. Break off.

Sew 2 leaves together at inside point. Attach Green to joining, ch 6, sl st in any sc on a Cherry, sl st in each ch across, sl st in same place on Leaf, ch 8, sl st in any sc on next Cherry, sl st in each ch across, sl st in Leaf, ch 6, sl st in any sc on next Cherry, sl st in each ch across, sl st in Leaf. Break off. Join all leaves and cherries the same way. Then sew cherries together. Sew in place around doily.

Join (48 sc). **4th and 5th rnds:** Repeat 2nd and 3rd rnds (96 sc on 5th rnd). **6th rnd:** Ch 4, tr in each sc around. Join. **7th rnd:** Sc in same place as sl st, sc in each tr around. Join. **8th rnd:** Sc in same place as sl st, * (ch 5, skip 2 sc, sc in next sc) twice; ch 5, skip 1 sc, sc in next sc. Repeat from * around, ending with ch 2, dc in first sc (36 loops). **9th rnd:** In loop just formed make sc, ch 3 and sc (picot made); * ch 5, in next loop make sc, ch 3 and sc (another picot). 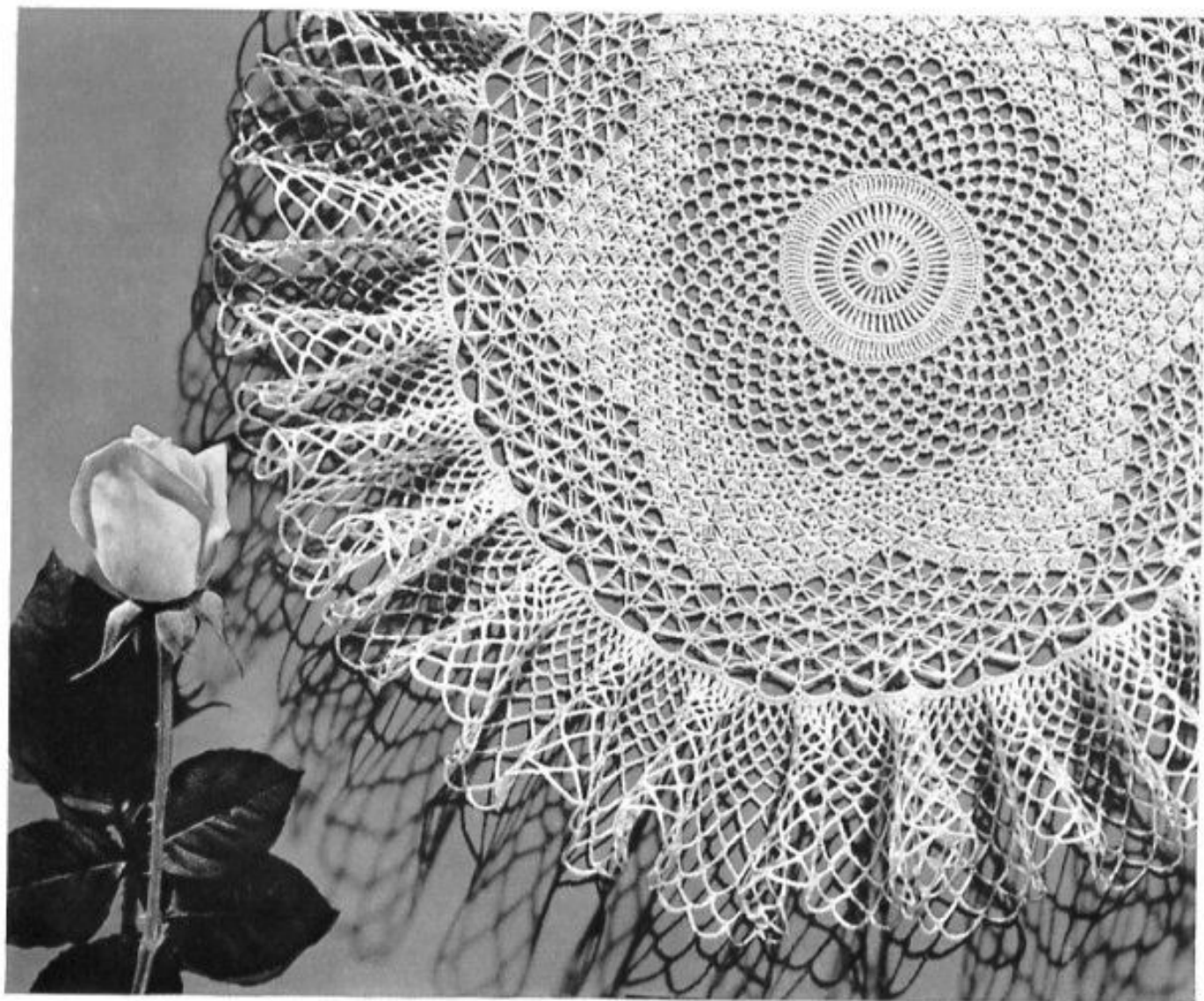

Join. **27th rnd:** Sl st to center dc of next shell, picot in same place, shell in next picot, * picot in next shell, make a knot st, dc in next picot, (make a knot st, sc in next knot st, next dc and next knot st, make a knot st, dc in center sc of next group) twice; make a knot st, sc in next knot st, next dc and next knot st, make a knot st, dc in next picot, make a knot st, (picot in next shell, shell in next picot) twice. Repeat from * around. Join. **28th rnd:** Sl st in next picot, shell in same place, * picot in next shell, make a knot st, dc in next picot, (make a knot st, sc in next knot st, in next dc and next knot st, make a knot st, dc in center sc of next 3-sc group) 3 times; make a knot st, sc in next knot st, in next dc and in next knot st, make a knot st, dc in next picot, make a knot st, picot in next shell, shell in next picot. Repeat from * around. Join.

29th rnd: Sl st to center of next shell, picot in same place, * make a knot st, dc in next picot, (make a knot st, sc in next knot st, next dc and in next knot st, make a knot st, dc in center sc of next sc group) 4 times; make a knot st, sc in next knot st, in next dc and next knot st, make a knot st, dc in next picot, make a knot st, picot in next shell. Repeat from * around. Join. **30th rnd:** Sl st in next picot, ch 3, * (make a knot st, sc in next knot st, next dc and next

knot st, make a knot st, dc in center sc of next sc group) 5 times; make a knot st, sc in next knot st, in next dc and in next knot st, make a knot st, dc in next picot. Repeat from * around. Join to top of ch-3. **31st rnd:** Sc in same place as sl st, sc in next knot st, * make a knot st, sc in next knot st, in next dc and in next knot st, make a knot st, dc in center sc of next sc group. Repeat from * around, ending with sc in last knot st. Join. **32nd rnd:** Ch 3, * make a knot st, sc in next knot st, in next dc and in next knot st, make a knot st, dc in center sc of next sc group. Repeat from * around. Join to top of ch-3. **33rd rnd:** Sc in same place as sl st, * ch 7, sc in next dc, ch 7, dc in center sc of next sc group. Repeat from * around. Join.

RUFFLE . . . 1st rnd: 8 sc in each sp around. Join. **2nd rnd:** Sc in same place as sl st, * ch 5, skip next sc, sc in next sc. Repeat from * around, ending with ch 2, dc in first sc. **3rd to 7th rnds incl:** * Ch 5, sc in next loop. Repeat from * around, ending with ch 2, dc in dc. **8th rnd:** * Ch 6, sc in next loop. Repeat from * around, ending with ch 3, dc in dc. **9th rnd:** * Ch 7, sc in next loop. Repeat from * around, ending with ch 3, tr in dc. **10th rnd:** * Ch 8, sc in next loop. Repeat from * around, ending with ch 4, tr in tr. **11th to 14th rnds incl:** * Ch 9, sc in next loop. Repeat from * around, ending with ch 5, tr in tr. At end of 14th rnd, ch 9, sl st in tr. Break off. Starch lightly and press.

Pear Trim S-593

J. & P. COATS "KNIT-CRO-SHEEN," Art. A.64: No. 10-A Canary Yellow, No. 43 Dk. Yellow and No. 48 Hunter's Green.

Coats & Clark's O.N.T. Six Strand Embroidery Floss, Art. C.11: No. 81-A Colonial Brown.

Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 5.

Each Pear requires 3 yards each of Canary Yellow and Dk. Yellow; each Leaf requires $1\frac{1}{4}$ yards of Hunter's Green.

Starting at center with 1 strand each of Canary Yellow and Dk. Yellow, ch 11. **1st rnd:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next 2 ch, half dc in next ch, dc and tr in next ch, tr in next 2 ch, tr and dc in next ch, half dc in next ch, 2 sc in last ch; work along opposite side of starting chain to correspond. Join to first sc. **2nd rnd:** Sc in next 5 sts, skip next st, sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 2 sts, skip 1 st, sl st in center chain, then work across other side to correspond. Join and break off. With Brown embroider lines at base of Pear.

LEAF (Make 2) . . . Work exactly as for Lemon Leaf No. S-590, page 11.

STEM . . . Attach Hunter's Green to top of Pear, ch 1, sl st in base of a Leaf, sl st in ch 1, sl st in base of next Leaf, then sl st in same place on Pear, then with thread in back of work, make a ch between leaves, ch 6 more, sl st in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across. Break off.

Watermelon Trim . . S-594

J. & P. COATS "KNIT-CRO-SHEEN," Art. A.64: No. 122 Watermelon, No. 49-A Killarney, No. 1 White and No. 12 Black.

Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 7.

Each piece measures $2\frac{1}{4}$ inches long and requires $1\frac{1}{2}$ yards of Watermelon, 1 yard of White and $\frac{3}{4}$ yard of Killarney. Scraps of Black for embroidery.

Starting at straight edge with Watermelon, ch 18. **1st rnd:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across; working across opposite side of starting chain, sl st in first ch, sc in same ch, sc in next ch, half dc in next 2 ch, dc in next 2 ch, tr in next 5 ch, dc in next 2 ch, half dc in next 2 ch, sc in last 2 ch, sl st in same ch as last sc was made. Break off. Now work in rows as follows: **1st row:** Attach White to first sl st made and, working in back loop of each st across, make sc in next st, (half dc in next st, 2 half dc in next st) 7

times; half dc in next st, sc in last st, sl st in sl st. Break off. **2nd row:** Attach Killarney to same place as White was attached, sc in back loop of each st across, sl st in point. Break off. With Black embroider seeds on Watermelon section.

Orange Trim S-595

J. & P. COATS "KNIT-CRO-SHEEN," Art. A.64: No. 43 Dk. Yellow and No. 48 Hunter's Green.

Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 7.

Each Orange requires $9\frac{1}{2}$ yards of Dk. Yellow; each Leaf requires $1\frac{1}{4}$ yards of Hunter's Green.

ORANGE . . . Starting at bottom with Dk. Yellow, ch 4. **1st rnd:** 9 dc in 4th ch from hook. Join to top of starting chain. **2nd rnd:** 2 sc in same place as sl st, sc in each dc around. **3rd rnd:** Sc in each sc around. **4th rnd:** * 2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc. Repeat from * around. **5th to 10th rnds incl:** Sc in each sc around. **11th, 12th and 13th rnds:** Dec 6 sc evenly on each rnd —to dec 1 sc, work off 2 sc as 1 sc. Then * work off next 2 sc as 1 sc. Repeat from * until all sc's have been worked off. Break off.

LEAF (Make 2) . . . Work exactly as for Lemon Leaf No. S-590, page 11. Complete as for Pear No. S-593.

Apple Trim S-596

J. & P. COATS "KNIT-CRO-SHEEN," Art. A.64: No. 1 White, No. 10-A Canary Yellow, No. 126 Spanish Red and No. 48 Hunter's Green.

Coats & Clark's O.N.T. Six Strand Embroidery Floss, Art. C.11: No. 81-A Colonial Brown.

Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 5.

Each Apple requires 2 yards each of White, Canary Yellow and Spanish Red; each Leaf requires $1\frac{1}{4}$ yards of Hunter's Green.

Starting at center with 1 strand each of White and Canary Yellow, ch 10. **1st rnd:** Half dc in 2nd ch from hook, dc in next ch, tr in next 2 ch, 2 tr in next ch, tr in next 2 ch, dc in next ch, make half dc, sl st and half dc in last ch (top of apple); work along opposite side of starting chain to correspond. Join and break off.

Attach a double strand of Spanish Red to first st, sc in same st and in next 5 sts, 2 sc in next st, skip 1 st, sl st into center chain. Complete other side to correspond. Join and break off.

LEAF . . . Work as for Lemon Leaf No. S-590, page 11 and complete Stem as for Pear No. S-593. Embroider seeds with Brown Embroidery Floss.

Repeat from * around (448 sts). **83rd rnd:** Sl 2 sts from left-hand needle to right-hand needle, * (O, k 2 tog) 3 times; O, k 1, O, (sl 1, k 1, p.s.s.o., k 1, k 2 tog, O, k 3, O) 4 times; sl 1, k 1, p.s.s.o., k 1, k 2 tog, O, k 1, O, (sl 1, k 1, p.s.s.o., O) 3 times; sl 1, k 1, p.s.s.o., k 1, k 2 tog. Repeat from * to last 51 sts, (O, k 2 tog) 3 times; O, k 1, O, (sl 1, k 1, p.s.s.o., k 1, k 2 tog, O, k 3, O) 4 times; sl 1, k 1, p.s.s.o., k 1, k 2 tog, O, k 1, O, (sl 1, k 1, p.s.s.o., O) 3 times; sl 1, k 1, p.s.s.o., k 1, then knit the first 2 slipped sts together (448 sts).

RUFFLE . . . 1st rnd: Insert hook in first st and draw thread through, ch 1, sc in same place. * sc in next 5 sts the same way, ch 5, insert hook through next 3 sts and complete an sc, ch 6, work off next 3 sts as 1 sc, ch 7, sc in next st, ch 8, work off 3 sts as 1 sc, ch 8, sc in next st, ch 9, work off 3 sts as 1 sc, ch 9, sc in next st, ch 10, work off 4 sts as 1 sc, ch 10, work off 3 sts as 1 sc, ch 10, work off 4 sts as 1 sc, ch 10, sc in next st, ch 9, work off 3 sts as 1 sc, ch 9, sc in next st, ch 8, work off 3 sts as 1 sc, ch 8, sc in next st, ch 7, work off 3 sts as 1 sc, ch 6, work off 3 sts as 1 sc, ch 5, sc in each of next 6 sts, work off 3 sts as 1 sc, sc in next st. Repeat from * around. **2nd rnd:** Sc in each sc of group, * 3 sc in next loop, (ch 5, sc in next loop) 16 times; ch 5, 3 sc in next loop, sc in each sc across group. Repeat from * around. Join. **3rd rnd:** Sc in each sc across group, * 6 sc in each of next 17 loops, sc in each sc across next group. Repeat from * around. Join. **4th rnd:** Sc in same place as sl st, * ch 6, skip 1 sc, sc in next sc. Repeat from * around. Join. **5th to 8th rnds incl:** Sl st to center of first loop, sc in same place, * ch 6, sc in next loop. Repeat from * around. Join. **9th to 12th rnds incl:** Work as for 5th rnd, having ch-7 loops on 9th rnd, ch-8 on 10th rnd, ch-9 on 11th rnd and ch-10 on 12th rnd. Break off at end of 12th rnd. Starch lightly and press.
